Since 1966, Father's Day has been celebrated nationally on the 3rd Sunday of June. The first widely recognized Father's Day celebration took place on June 19, 1910, in Spokane Washington by Sonora Smart Dodd who was inspired by the popularity of Mother's Day and to recognize her

own father who raised her and her 5 other siblings on his own. Over the years, we've hopefully had the chance to celebrate fathers and all those who take on a fatherly role. But ultimately, every good thing that we consider fatherly is modeled after the goodness of God as Father. The Fatherhood of God is not a metaphor in order to personify an unknowable divine being. Rather, God as Father is at the very heart of Divine Revelation. As the Nicene Creed reminds us all of creation flows from the Father, through the Son and in the unity of the Holy Spirit. Even more, God is Father because of His covenant of love, first with the Chosen People of Israel and also now with us. As a Father, God enters into a loving relationship with His people and provides for, protects and guides us. Even though as finite creatures, it can be difficult to understand an infinite, all-knowing, and all-powerful God, our Lord cares us as His children and cares for us beyond all measure. He knows everything about us, right down the number of hairs on our head. The entire history of salvation demonstrates the Father's plan to bring us, His children, home. 

**1st Grade Religious Education
Catechist Needed**

Over the past few years, our 1st Grade Religious Education enrollment has continued to grow, and we are now seeking a second 1st Grade Catechist to join our Faith Formation team.

A catechist is someone who lets the Word of God echo through their life, sharing their faith journey and helping children learn how to live their faith each day. Our 1st Grade students begin by learning about God as our loving Father and Jesus growing up in a family just like theirs. Throughout the year, they discover what it means to belong to a parish family, celebrate the Sacraments, pray together, and grow in their relationship with God.

No teaching experience is necessary. Lesson plans are fully developed, easy to follow, and include engaging classroom activities that support each lesson. You will also have the support of one or two classroom aides, depending on class size, so you will not be teaching alone.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Plan and teach according to the curriculum and lesson plans that will be provided. Utilize resources provided or ones that you may find.
- Review your final lesson plan weekly with Joanna for support so copies and supplies can be obtained for your classroom.
- Arrive on Sundays at 9:00 AM to set up your classroom prior to student arrival at 9:30 AM.
- Successfully complete a background check with the Diocese as well as Virtus Training.

TRAINING and SUPPORT:

- Training, materials and ongoing support will be provided throughout the year.

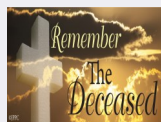
