This Monday, June 29th, is the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, one of the most important feast days in the life of the Church year. Not only does it recognize two great Apostles, both Peter and Paul symbolize the twofold nature of the Church herself. St. Peter is the bedrock and firm foundation on which the Church is grounded upon - the deposit of faith, as well as being the icon for the Vicar of Christ (aka the Pope). St. Paul is the expression of the Church's missionary zeal, of going out to all the nations proclaiming the Good News. According to ancient tradition, both Peter and Paul were put to death during the persecution of Christians under the Emperor Nero following the Great Fire of Rome in 64 AD. St. Peter died by crucifixion near the Vatican hill. St. Paul was beheaded outside the city proper. Their blood, poured out at the heart of the Roman empire, consecrated Rome as the new heart of Christendom. As early as 285 AD, there is evidence that the feast of Ss. Peter and Paul were already celebrated on the same day. As St. Augustine wrote, "Both apostles share the same feast day, for these two were one; and even though they suffered on different days, they were as one." As we honor these two pillars of the Church, we recall that, even though they are great saints, they were ordinary people who were open to the will of God in their lives. They responded, and God used them in ways they could have never imagined. Even though St. Peter denied Christ three times and St. Paul persecuted Christians, our Lord still used them to be the Rock of the Church and the Apostle to the Nations. Just imagine what God could do with us if we did the same! Ss. Peter and Paul, pray for us!

Considering the dichotomy between Ss. Peter and Paul, I figure that I would give you a recipe that is both sweet and savory. After reviewing several promising contenders, I give you: Bacon Chocolate Chip Cheesecake Blondies. You had me at bacon! 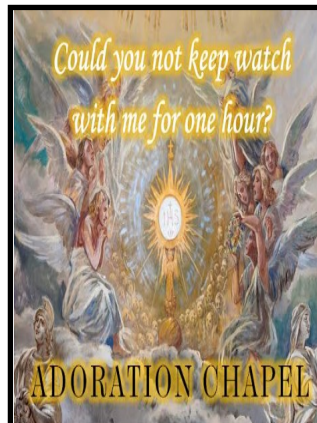

- Review your final lesson plan weekly with Joanna for support so copies and supplies can be obtained for your classroom.
- Arrive on Sundays at 9:00 AM to set up your classroom prior to student arrival at 9:30 AM.
- Successfully complete a background check with the Diocese as well as Virtus Training

Meaning, if you want your child to receive 1st Reconciliation and 1st Communion in 2nd grade, they completed First Grade preparation through Religious Ed Sessions or through Catholic School.

Did you know our Religious Ed program begins in kindergarten? For the past 6 years we have offered an amazing Kindergarten Class. Our young parishioners are just beginning their spiritual journey.

During their Religious Education sessions, they become aware of all of God's creation as well as Jesus' great love for them as the Good Shepherd. They are introduced to aspects of faith through stories, songs and crafts that help them see God's love and desire for personal relationship with each of us, and how we can respond to God's invitation.

### **Faith Formation for Special Needs Youth of ALL Ages**

We are excited to be working with several families with special needs children from 6 years old to 14 years old. 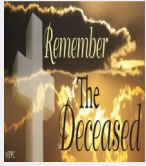

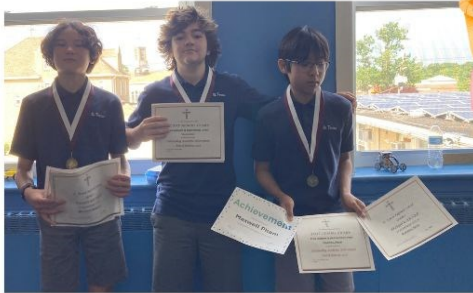
