Exiit qui seminat - "The sower goes out to sow"

On Friday of this past week, the parish celebrated the Mass of Christian Burial for Charles Mansfield. The fact that I even have to type these words seems very much out of place. I could have never fathomed that when Charles and I parted company early on Sunday morning, June the 29th, that it would be the last time we would see each other. It seems impossible that someone so full of life could be gone from our lives. The first time that I heard his name was putting together the sponsors for the Lawn Festival: The Mansfields of San Diego, CA (the phrase had to be exact). As a Lawn Festival "rookie", I was informed that Charles and Denise Mansfield were devoted and active members of the parish who moved to San Diego to be closer to their daughter, Megan, and her family. However, without fail, Charles would fly back into town for the Lawn Festival. Truth be told, I had forgotten that Charles would be at the parish in person, especially since Monday and Tuesday nights were a combined 200 degrees (99 as a high on Monday and 101 on Tuesday). Charles was both taken aback and deeply touched when I thanked him personally for flying in for the Lawn Festival. When you travel over 2700 miles to be somewhere, you need to get a "shout out". Charles made it a point to introduce himself (a shrinking violet he was not) and we talked about his history in the parish.

Charles was an open book and never shy or reserved about talking about his life, his family and the things that he loved. He talked about being a proud alumnus of West Catholic High School in Philadelphia and how both he and his brother Michael spent time at St. Charles Borromeo Seminary when it was in Wynnewood, PA. Charles spoke of time in the Army and being a Vietnam veteran. But other than his family, the one thing that Charles Mansfield held so dear was this parish. Many people have connections to specific buildings and institutions and the important and seminal memories that accompany those places. Charles was unique



in the fact that his devotion to the parish was rooted in her people. It was the relationships that meant the most to Charles. It was the reason why he kept coming back to Lawn Festival after Lawn Festival, not for the event in and of itself, but for the greater sense of community that our Lawn Festival fosters. The love of neighbor, the love of parishioners is, at its heart, a reflection of our love of God. Being an active part of a parish is not just staying connected or merely taking care of those who are sick or in need. The word parish comes from the Greek

word: $\pi a \rho \delta \kappa i a$ (a dwelling or a gathering of the community). A parish is our spiritual home in which we gather together in God's presence. It's where we enter into true communion with our Lord and one another. As a community we mourn the loss of any of our parishioners. But as people of faith, we truly understand that they are, God-willing, with us still as a part of the communion of saints and united in the Beatific Vision of Almighty God. So, in your kindness, pray for the repose of the soul of Charles J. Mansfield who lived in San Diego, CA, but who still prayed with and loved the good people of Holy Child Parish.

By the way, the price of gas in San Diego, CA is currently \$4.79 a gallon. #IFKYK






