Exiit qui seminat: "The sower goes out to sow"

We're taking a temporary departure from our parish discussion of the 6 post-conciliar (meaning flowing from the 2nd Vatican Council) principles put forth by Pope Leo XIV in order to talk about another of those special feast days that replace Sundays in Ordinary Time: the Exaltation of the Holy Cross. The feast day has its origins in the 4th century, when St. Helena, the mother of the Emperor Constantine, discovered the relic of the True Cross while on pilgrimage to Jerusalem. Constantine had a church built on the site of the cross' discovery, the Church of the Holy Sepulchre, and it was dedicated on September 14, 335 AD. Originally, the Exaltation of the Holy Cross was celebrated and spread in the Eastern part of the Catholic Church, centered around the city of Constantinople. The feast day entered the liturgical calendar in the West (aka the Roman Catholic Church) in the 7th century, after the cross was recovered from the Persians who absconded with it in 614 AD.



This feast day is so important because it discusses the necessity of the cross and the redemptive value of suffering. While in modern times, the cross has been turned into "a thing of beauty to be carried in procession or worn as jewelry", in Jesus' time, the cross was the most extreme form of punishment for anyone foolish enough to oppose the authority of Rome. It was a fate reserved for the most heinous acts and the worst of offenders. Crucifixion is truly a brutal way to die - a combination of exposure, exhaustion and asphyxiation. Add on top of that the indignity of carrying the means of your execution through the busy streets of Jerusalem to suffer the buffets and spitting of the jeering crowd. But Christ Himself takes this object of defeat and torture and transforms it into the symbol of our salvation. We know that the glory of Easter Sunday is impossible without the sacrifice of Good Friday. But Christ's sufferings were not just His own. Our Blessed Mother also shared in His cross. As Simeon foretold in the temple, "Behold, this child is destined for the fall and rise of many in Israel, and to be a sign that will be contradicted (and you yourself a sword will pierce) so that the thoughts of many hearts may be revealed" (Luke 2:34-35). These swords of sorrow become the basis of our devotion to Our Lady of Sorrows which is celebrated the very next day, September the 15th, and, Mary, as the first and greatest disciple, gives us an example of what we too must do in order to follow in the footsteps of our Lord and Savior. The glory of the cross, and the weight of its sacrifice, is ours, too, to carry. Let us embrace the cross with trust, knowing it unites us to Christ's redeeming love. For the sign of the cross is our strength, our protection, and our constant reminder that God's love has the final word.

I finally got the chance to cook the zucchini and the eggplant that was given to me by parishioners. There is nothing like garden fresh vegetables! While PROBABLY not the most dietetic, these recipes were SO GOOD and got the Fr. Britto 'Seal of Approval!' SHOUT ... SHINE ... SHARE!

"Always be ready to give an explanation, for a reason for your hope."

This year's Catechetical theme '**Shout, Shine, Share**', challenges us to empower our youth to become active and confident evangelists. As Christians, we are called to boldly proclaim our faith, live out our beliefs in visible ways, and share the Gospel message with those around us. But the question remains, *how do we do this?*



We will be focusing on three core elements:

SHOUT

We want our youth to discover and strengthen their *faith voice*. This means encouraging them to be bold and confident in speaking about what they believe. Shouting is not about volume, but about courage, moving beyond a quiet voice, building confidence that encourages our young believers to speak up and shout out.

SHINE

Inspired by Jesus' words, "*Let your light shine*" (Mt 5:16), we will focus on how actions and character make God's love visible. Shining means living in such a way that others can see Christ reflected in us. Good deeds, compassion, honesty, and integrity all become a light that guides others closer to God.

SHARE

As missionary disciples, we are called to share our faith personally and authentically. Sharing involves both words and action: telling our own faith stories, serving others, and creating moments where the love of Christ is made real.

Throughout this school year, we will explore three guiding questions together:

- **Why** should we share our faith?
- **What** message are we called to communicate?

How can I share that message with others?

These three elements ... **Shout, Shine, and Share** ... will guide our journey as we help our young people grow into joyful witnesses of Christ. Throughout the year, we will engage not only in classroom learning but also in Family Events designed for all ages. Together, these opportunities will strengthen both faith and community. We look forward to an amazing year ahead and can't wait to get started!

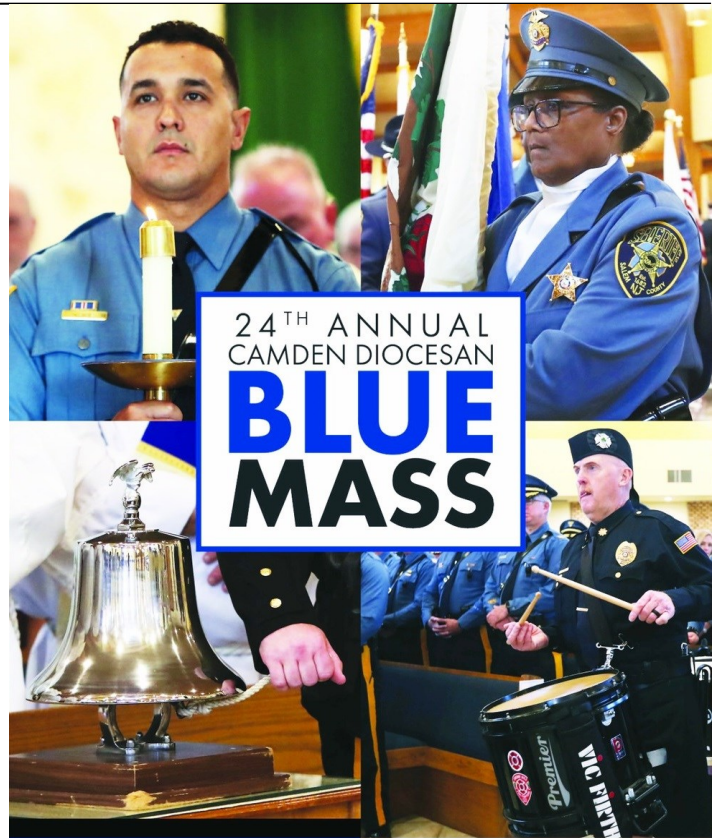

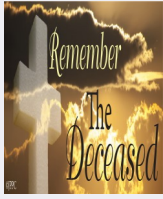
