Exiit qui seminat - "The sower goes out to sow"

This Sunday we celebrate the 5th day of the Octave of Christmas, our 8-day celebration of the Birth of Christ AND the 6th Day of the 12 Days of Christmas - the Feast of the Holy Family. A relatively newer feast (or at least new in terms of the Church), the Feast of the Holy Family began in Canada in the 17th century by St. François de Laval, the first bishop of Quebec, as a way to strengthen Christian family life. It wasn't until 1921 that Pope Benedict XV declared the Feast of the Holy Family a feast day for the universal Church to be celebrated on the Sunday after the Feast of the Epiphany. With the liturgical changes of the 2nd Vatican Council, the feast of the Holy Family was moved to the Sunday of the Octave of Christmas (or December 30th if there is no Sunday between Christmas and the Epiphany). The strongly held belief for the feast day was to present the Holy Family as a model for all Christian families, especially to counter the breakdown of the family unit. The ongoing hope of the Church is that devotion to the Holy Family would lead to the strengthening of the family unity amongst both the family itself and in greater society. While there are many blended and non-traditional families that do thrive, they are far from the ideal. In addition, we recognize that Jesus, Mary and Joseph were not strangers to strife and turmoil. As we hear in Luke's Gospel, Jesus at the age of 12, leaves His mother and foster father in order to do the will of the Father. While our Lord certainly knew what He was doing, one can only imagine what Mary and Joseph went through! That's IN ADDITION to their fleeing from Bethlehem to Egypt after King Herod "the Great" ordered the death of every Jewish male child up the age of 2 in that region. So to borrow a phrase from the very popular advertising campaign, "Jesus, Mary and Joseph get us". They know how hard it is to raise a family and the pressures that go along with it. But in the midst of everything, the loving environment that existed between Jesus, Mary and Joseph still allowed our Lord to grow in wisdom and in strength. And so it is for us. The example of Jesus, Mary and Joseph is not to be a perfect family, but to be a holy one in the midst of life as we know it. As a parish, let us continue to pray and support our families as we best know how. Merry Christmas!

While there is no technical food or dessert for the Feast of the Holy Family, we can always live out the spirit of the feast day. Maybe cook together as a family (as long as it doesn't turn into a full contact sport)? Prepare a treasured family recipe, especially one that your grandparents used to make! Finally, in the spirit of hospitality, invite a neighbor to join in a meal!

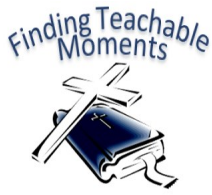
We go from one busy season to the next without ever truly sitting down to rest and just be with our Lord. We are not made to go without rest. We are made to be in a relationship with our Lord

Hospitality Committee Wellness Check *Staying Connected by Lifting Spirits*

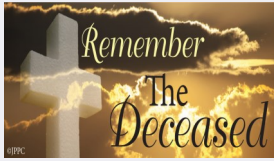
