Studio Tech and Dress Rehearsals

Technical and Dress rehearsals are essential to a smooth running show. Small lineup changes may occur after these rehearsals as we sort out potential quick changes or other plot adjustments. Classes will not change shows or acts that they perform in.

We wish we could wave a magic wand and ensure that every family with multiple dancers and multiple dances are in the same show for convenience's sake, but unfortunately there are some conflicts we cannot avoid. We do our absolute best to minimize these conflicts, but please understand that coordinating show times and plots makes this very difficult.

- Please arrive for technical rehearsal on 5/30 in class attire with hair pulled back: NO COSTUMES.
- Please arrive for dress rehearsal on 6/6 in your FIRST COSTUME with hair done for dress rehearsal.
- **Please attend at the time(s) noted in the table below based on the Show (1, 2, and/or 3) and Act (I or II) your dancer's class is listed in the [lineup on pages 9-11](#).**
- STUDIO TECH AND DRESS REHEARSALS ARE CLOSED; NO PARENT VIEWING.
- **Saturday Twinkletoes, Storybook, and Kinderdance will attend Tech and Dress rehearsals during their class time and then return to class after practicing their dance.**

Full Tech and Dress Rehearsal, 6/12/26

- Full dress rehearsal is open to parents, however, we highly recommend having the recital be your first viewing of your dancer's performance.
- Please arrive 15 minutes before the designated act time in full makeup and first costume.
- **ALL LITTLE DANCERS (Twinkletoes, Storybook, Preschool Acro, Primary Dance Explore, Primary Acro, Kinderdance, KinderHop, and Ballet Jazz) will attend at 11:00 AM, regardless of what show or act they perform in for the full dress rehearsal on 6/12. Littles will not rehearse the curtain call.**
- **Wait in the audience** until your act is called backstage; **you may leave as soon as your dancer rehearses the curtain call.** We will rehearse the curtain call between Act I and Act II of each show.
- Dancers under 10 years old will receive a color-coded wristband on this day for Recital Day drop off and pick up the next day. The adult who is dropping off/picking up the dancer should wear this wristband on Recital day.
- Dancers who are self-sufficient and need to change between dances may use the dressing room on this day. All other dancers need to wait in the audience with a responsible adult.

- **Dancers of all ages will stay for the entirety of the show, as they all take their bows in the finale/curtain call and we have a strict [drop off and pick up procedure](#).**
- All persons occupying a seat in the auditorium require a ticket, tickets will be scanned at the door.

Recital Day Pick-Up and Drop-Off

- **Recital Day Drop Off- Before Show:**

- **Dressing Room Volunteers**, please arrive **45 minutes before showtime** (9:15 am, 12:15 pm or 4:15 pm). Check in at the Recital Volunteer table to receive your class list and name badge.
- **Front of House, Ushers/Ticket Scanners**, please arrive 45 minutes before show time. Check in at the Recital Volunteer table.
- **All families:** please drop off your dancer(s) **30 minutes before showtime** at the Dancer Check In table, and the volunteer will bring them to their designated class areas in the LWW auditorium lobby.
- Unless volunteering, do not bring them any earlier than 30 min ahead of show time.
- Parents of children ages 10 and under will receive a color coded wristband at **Friday's full dress rehearsal**. Write your child's name on this wristband, and the adult doing drop off/pick up wears it to the recital to make the day go smoothly.
- Please familiarize yourself with the NAME of your dancer's class (i.e. "Twinkletoes", "Storybook", "Kinderdance", "Kinderhop", "Ballet 2", "Hip Hop 3" etc) so that the check in process runs efficiently.
- Do not send your dancer with any extra belongings or items that could be misplaced outside of their costume(s) and dance shoes.

- **Recital Day Pick Up- After Finale:**

- Pick up your dancer(s) (one parent/family member with the color coded wristband **ONLY**) in an orderly fashion and check out with the class volunteer **AFTER the curtain call** of the show. All dancers are to stay backstage/in the green room until the end of the show. We are working diligently during those raffles and finale to make sure your dancer is ready for pickup, stay seated until Miss Lauren dismisses the audience so the flow of traffic goes smoothly.
- **There is no early pickup for dancers unless there are extenuating circumstances or in case of emergency.** Your dancers are in the good hands of our staff and volunteers for the duration of the show, so make sure you take the chance to enjoy it without worrying about your little one!
- Please be patient and allow our volunteers to perform their duties. Only volunteers are permitted backstage and to the holding area in order to reduce traffic and ensure a smooth, orderly, and safe dismissal.

Recital Volunteering

Recital Volunteer Form: Due April 12th

Our volunteers help ensure that the dancers have an enjoyable experience and keep them all safe throughout their time backstage and in the green room as well as help our pre-recital days go smoothly. Volunteer roles for pre-recital dates are first-come first-serve for the roles with only a few spaces needed. **We reserve the right to assign parent volunteers where they are most needed, though we provide the opportunity to select a preference.**

- Volunteers receive pre-order privileges before tickets go on sale to the public.
- **All Company Parents must volunteer for at least one show or pre-recital duties.**
- Dressing room volunteers **do not** need to purchase a ticket for themselves for the show they are volunteering for. All other volunteers will receive a coupon code for a free ticket.
- Please fill out the Google Form linked above, which has links within to select your specific preference of role.

Recital Day Volunteer Roles

- GIRL'S DRESSING ROOM MOMS (or aunts, grandmas, sisters) are responsible for a specific dance class or group of children for one performance, remaining with them from drop off until the last child is picked up by their designated adult. These volunteers are allowed to watch their assigned group's performance from backstage. **We need the most volunteers here.**
- BOY'S DRESSING ROOM DADS (or uncles, grandpas, brothers) are responsible for the entire boys dressing room, remaining with them until the last child is picked up by their designated adult. These volunteers are allowed to watch their assigned group's performance backstage.
- USHERS/ Ticket scanners are also needed at each performance. We need only a few volunteers in this role, to scan tickets, hand out programs, help folks find their seats, and manage crowds.
- FUNDRAISERS and DINNER volunteers are generally asked individually to serve in that role. Please let us know if you have been asked/assigned that role.

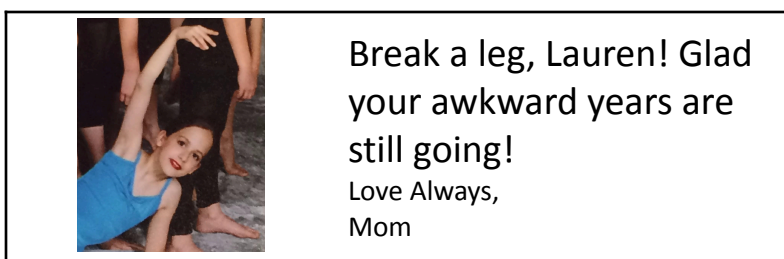
Pre-Recital Volunteer Roles

- PICTURE DAY 5/3/26 volunteers assist with dancer drop off and pick up for picture day at Momentum Dance Studio.
- STUDIO TECH REHEARSAL 5/30/26 volunteers assist with dancer drop off and pick up for rehearsals at Momentum Dance Studio.
- STUDIO DRESS REHEARSAL 6/6/26 volunteers assist with dancer drop off and pick up for dress rehearsal at Momentum Dance Studio.
- FULL TECH/DRESS REHEARSAL 6/12/26 @ LWW assist the volunteer coordinator to distribute wristbands, set up class designation areas, and organize dressing room volunteer folders.

Volunteers will be contacted at least 2 weeks before the show if their assignment changes and with specific information on their responsibilities. Please note: volunteer spots are assigned based on a first-come/first-serve basis but with preference given to assigning dressing room volunteers to their own child's group. We reserve the right to shift the volunteer sign-ups if necessary.

Tickets, Pre-Orders, Program Ads, Pictures, Trophies

- Tickets go on sale **April 13th to recital volunteers** and **April 20th to the public**. Ticket Link: <https://30288.danceticketing.com/> This is an assigned seating event, and tickets will be scanned at the door.
- There are tiered ticketing prices based on the seating choices within the theater. Any person occupying a seat regardless of age must have a ticket.
- We recommend little ones ages 3 and under sit on laps to avoid this extra ticket cost.
- **Please make sure you are purchasing tickets for the correct show (see [lineup on pages 9-11](#)).**
 - **Show 1 @ 10:00 AM**, **Show 2 @ 1:00 PM**, **Show 3 @ 5:00 PM**
- **[Recital Pre-Order Form](#)** includes: **recital t-shirt, flower bouquets, trophies, shoes/tights and nude leotards, and program ads, due April 24th.**
 - Everything ordered will be a la carte, meaning you do not have to purchase everything listed, only the items desired.
 - All Twinkletoes, Storybook, and all ballet levels wear (prima) pink tights with pink ballet shoes. All other styles wear skin tone tights if needed. Hip Hop levels do not need tights if wearing pants, **and should wear black gym shoes with white soles** (any brand).
 - **Dinner between 1PM and 5PM shows:** dinner will be offered between recital shows if your dancer is participating in both shows. The cost is \$15 and includes Jimmy John's sandwich, chips/snack, fruit/veggie, and water.
 - **Recital Program Dancer/Family/Friends Ads:** Congratulate your dancer with a recital program ad!! "Well Wisher" ad ¼ page: \$35; ½ page ad: \$65; full page ad: \$120



- **Pictures** will be taken by **Ron McKinney Photography on May 3**. **Group photos are mandatory**, though you do not have to order them (just great memorabilia!). The schedule will be sent in April.
 - Individual photos are optional. Online orders will be sent ahead of time. Arrive in full hair/makeup/costume and find your class in and around the studio and wait to be called. **No Parents Inside.**
- **TROPHIES:** If your dancer is due to receive their 5, 10, or 15 year trophy, the recital pre-order form **MUST** be filled out to receive it.

Hair, Makeup, and Costume Care

Join us on **Saturday, April 25th at 9 AM** for a hair and makeup tutorial at Momentum! Bring your dancer to practice on and the following supplies:

- Hair supplies: water spray bottle, hair ties, bobby pins, a hairnet, smoothing brush, parting comb, hairspray
- Makeup supplies: neutral eyeshadow (beige, browns, soft colors that complement your dancer's eye color if you like), blush, "berry" colored lipstick (not a harsh red), mascara, eyeliner and false lashes (if you're feeling up for it for our older dancers!), foundation/concealer/contour/bronzer (again, for the older dancers if you're feeling up for it), lip liner, setting powder
- Other supplies: Q-tips, micellar water and cotton pads or remover, makeup brushes

Hair

For all dancers with long hair, it should be in a low and neat ballet bun with a center part unless otherwise specified.

- [Bun Tutorial](#)- for the littles it's also okay to use the bun "donut" if necessary.
- For boys: style how you wish to ensure it stays out of their eyes and neat onstage.

Makeup

Your dancer is already naturally beautiful, and does not need makeup to be beautiful! However, **stage makeup lets the audience see their faces while the theatre lighting washes them out.**

- **Full stage makeup includes:** foundation, blush, lipstick, eyeliner, mascara, false eyelashes, and eyeshadow. For young dancers- attempt at least blush, mascara, and lipstick (we know how hard it can be to stand still). [Dance Recital makeup tips](#)
- **Boys:** Makeup is not required, but it is encouraged! The stage lights will wash out the face and features so it's good just to highlight those with makeup. Here's a good tutorial: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=SxQ_A82RXJk

Costume Care

- When your dancer receives their costume(s), we recommend they stay hanging up in the garment bag they're received in, and always travel in the garment bag.
- Label all costume pieces and accessories with your dancer's name as soon as they're received.
- Make sure your dancer tries on their costume(s) at home **immediately** after receiving them.
- Most costumes will need to be steamed to release wrinkles and to get tutus presentable.
- Costumes are not to be worn for any reason outside of Picture Day, Dress Rehearsals, and the shows.
- If for any reason your dancer's costume does not fit, let the front desk know immediately. These costumes are ordered according to the specific measurements taken and ordered long ahead of time, so are not easily exchanged or replaced. If there are easy fixes such as hemming, tacking straps, etc, please do so.

Momentum Show and Rehearsal Rules

- 1. Costumes must be paid for in full before the studio can order them.**
- 2. Mark your name on all costumes, shoes, hats, props, etc. in a place that is not visible when you are onstage.**
3. No gum. Ever.
4. Diamond-like stud earrings will be the only allowed jewelry. No bracelets, rings, necklaces, or dangle earrings. Similarly, no colored nail polish or fake nails.
5. No underwear visible/showing under costumes. We advise a skin-toned leotard or undergarments.
6. Makeup should be applied at home to avoid dressing room clutter.
7. We recommend a nude leotard under costumes for ease of changing costumes in the dressing room.
8. No friends or non-performing siblings in the dressing rooms/studio.
9. Only dancers that are in the next dance or have a 1 dance quick-change may be backstage.
10. All dancers are required to stay at rehearsals until dismissed by Miss Lauren. On recital day, all dancers are required to stay until after the curtain call (See dismissal procedure on page 3).
11. Do not bring valuables with you to rehearsal or performance.
12. No food or drinks anywhere in costume.
13. Keep the dressing rooms neat. Use the garbage cans provided and keep personal items in your dance bags. Volunteer moms are not responsible for any dancers' belongings.
14. Email Miss Lauren with the code word "Curiouser and curiouser" for 5 free raffle tickets for reading all of the rules.
15. All seats are reserved. An usher will help audience members find the seats for their party. Anyone who takes a seat will be charged the ticket price. Keep toddlers on laps to avoid an extra ticket.
- 16. No video or photography is allowed on show day.** Video and non-flash photography are allowed on Full Dress Rehearsal day. **The show is professionally recorded and all recital families will receive a copy afterwards per our recital fee. Please don't let your screens distract performers or obstruct the professional recording by using them during the show. We have the right to remove audience members who violate this rule.**
17. Remember to use the washrooms before the show and during intermission, not during the performance.
18. Proper theatre etiquette is expected of our audience members, please be respectful of the dancers by remaining seated while they are dancing onstage.

Show Lineups:

The next page contains the lineups for all 3 shows, please first look for your dancers class in the far right column to avoid any confusion. We do our best to avoid conflicts, but know it is impossible to avoid. The order of the lineups will change as we go as we find quick changes or other conflicts, but dances will remain in the same show and act they are placed in. Please purchase tickets based on these lineups.
