Meeting was called to order at 6:31 pm by President Joe Freiburger

Pastors Report: None.

Treasurers Report: Deena gave a summary of the October treasurer's reports. There were no deposits from Tithely in October. It is known that money was taken out of at least one member's account andwent to Tithely. Deena is still working with Tithely to resolve this. The reports were approved subject to audit.

Food Pantry – Joe gave a summary of the written report from Dave. Pantry has been very busy. Things are going well. The Brethren and the Methodist Churches have both been collecting food and donating to the pantry. The list of most needed items might be adjusted to include more things.

Fellowship –Mark. The Bread loaf offering for October was \$147 to the Firemen's candy collection. The advent event was mentioned above. Setting up a Cards/Game night was also discussed. Perhaps something could be set up for February. Linda will make some calls and seek a volunteer to lead this.

It is used by Sigma Eta but not longer stays in tune. Paul will look into the pianos in the fellowship hall and in the balcony.

Stewardship – Linda went over some of her plans from the time and talent sheets. She is still contacting people who said they were interested in helping.

Permanent Endowment – Paul. Nothing to report.
