Please add the cost of an alternative container or casket, urn, any optional facilities and staff charges (shown below), optional merchandise (shown below), cemetery expenses, and any other cash advance items.

Minnesota law does not require you to purchase a casket for cremation. If you want to arrange a cremation, you can use a cremation container. A cremation container is a combustible, closed container that encases the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or corrugated cardboard and into which a dead human body is placed prior to insertion into a cremation chamber for cremation. The containers we provide are minimum cardboard, theamation, prairieview and meadowview.

Identification and Family Viewing

Minnesota law does not require a family to identify or view the deceased prior to cremation or burial, however, it is advised. When selected, the viewing will take place in the alternative container you select and a charge of \$275.00 for the care of the body with no embalming will be added. When an autopsy or tissue donation as been performed, we charge \$475.00 for the basic care of the body with no embalming. If you are scheduling a separate family viewing, a visitation room charge of \$200 will be added.

Lakewood's crematory fee of \$425.00 will be added to each cremation package above.

The crematory has additional charges for bariatric individuals (\$135.00) or to witness the cremation (\$225.00).

Depending on the county of death, the medical examiner/coroner may impose an additional charge for cremation authorization.
