Elaine's first marriage was unfortunately unhappy. They had two children and muddled on. After several years, Elaine divorced, losing custody of daughter Patty and keeping son Michael.

A bright light shone when Elaine met and married David Masman. He legally adopted Elaine's son and gave Elaine two more daughters. He was a deacon of the church as well as the general manager of the Courier Express. They bought a

summer home at Fawn Lake and stayed there seasonally from May through September. Every tax season they put their resources into renewing and refurbishing the summer home they shared for 45 years.

Many fond memories flood Elaine's mind as she excitedly recalls Fawn Lake. Her family had bought the properties around her so everyone could enjoy close family gatherings. After retirement, they were snow birding between Florida and Fawn Lake, six months here, six months there. For them, Christmas was always in July because of the traveling. The families and neighbors enjoyed the decorations and merriment of the season.

Elaine loves her three children. Michael runs his own company and resides in W. Seneca. Karen works in the insurance industry and lives in Tonawanda. Kelly works with the handicapped and lives in Oswego, NY. There are eight grandchildren. She has always loved making crafts and giving them away. Her stay here at Heathwood offers her craft time, playing bingo and developing an affection for Rummikub. And.... she loves being here where she finally feels spoiled.
