

Guidelines for Participation in The Green Mountain Photo Show 2026

Mad River Valley Arts strives to present the very best quality in exhibitions. Please review the guidelines for the preparation of artwork.

Info about the show

- The Green Mountain Photo Show is non-juried.
- The work must be the sole creation of the photographer.
- The show is open to amateur and professional photographers.
- All work must be for sale.
- Participants may bring up to three entries with a minimum framed size of 11" x 14" for the main exhibition, plus one entry for the Small Works exhibition with a maximum frame size of 14" in any direction.

Registration

- The registration form must be filled out and signed.
- Submission of a registration form acknowledges your understanding that all work is shown uninsured.
- The show reserves the right to refuse any works for any reason.
- All work must remain on display for the duration of the exhibition, unless sold.
- Sold work may be removed from the exhibition once full payment has been processed. The artist then has the option to replace the work with a similar piece.
- Photographers are encouraged to place one 8.5" x 11" page (printed on white paper) with a bio and/or artist statement in the exhibition book.

Delivery

- Work needs to be delivered to the correct exhibition location at the scheduled time.
- All work must be labeled on the reverse side with the artist's name, contact info, title and price.
- If framed, frames need to be sturdy and in good condition.
- All work must be properly wired for hanging with no exposed glass edges.
- Canvas edges on gallery-wrapped work need to be finished and without visible hardware (tacks, staples, etc.) except when the same are part of the design of the piece.
- No cloth, cardboard, or sawtooth hangers - the exception being work presented on metal plates with built in hangers.
- If work requires a display stand or pedestal, the stand or pedestal is the responsibility of the artist with approval by the curator or exhibition staff.
- The exhibition curator and/or staff reserve the right to not accept or present work failing to meet the guidelines.

Volunteer To Sit The show!

- All photographers are encouraged to volunteer to be a docent for the show. We have seen increased sales when the public can speak to the artist about their work! Any photographer sitting the show is allowed to display extra photos in the lobby area. An easel will be provided. For more information and to sign up to volunteer.
