- understand how to use their industrial entitlements to support solutions.
- understand and practice negotiation skills.
- create a plan for action in their workplace.

Creating a Safe and Healthy Workplace

Get a crash course on workplace health and safety legislation. We'll cover the process of risk management and the hierarchy of controls. You'll leave with a range of knowledge about the current health and safety issues facing nurses and midwives and how you can be part of changing things at work. A must for nurses and midwives concerned about unsafe workplaces.

By the end of this course participants will:

- have a sound understanding of the role of a Health and Safety Representative according to the Work Health and Safety Act 2011
- understand the concept of "reasonably practicable".
- understand Provisional Improvement Notices (PINS) and the right to cease unsafe work.
- able to specify the obligations of an employer to Health and Safety Representatives
- know where to locate relevant work health and safety resources available to them.
- understand the risk assessment process.
- understand current workplace health and safety issues facing nurses and midwives.

- the importance of workload management
- coronial and nursing and midwifery tribunal cases
- developing a plan to resolve conflict between professional standards and employer directives.
