

Becoming a Job Delegate (JD)

Job Delegates play an important role for ANMF NT. They are the ANMF NT in the workplace, and are responsible for:

- Maintaining the link between members and the ANMF NT office
- Assisting with advising members about rights and accessing their entitlements
- Supporting the Organiser to ensure that agreements and awards are appropriately applied in the workplace
- Recruiting new members

This is a voluntary role you may choose to be involved as much, or as little as you can / like:

- You are not in this alone. We understand that your daily schedule is busy, we will leave this decision up to you
- How involved you may choose to be, we will support you throughout your journey

How do you become a Job Delegate?

- Any financial member of the ANMF NT may be nominated to be a Job Delegate.
- Please note that members are expected to undertake training provided by the ANMF NT & attend Job Delegate **monthly** meetings. If Job Delegates do not assist or attend meetings, JD status may be revoked.

In order to become a workplace representative, or JD you need to:

- Be nominated by three (3) financial members of the ANMF NT

What happens to your nomination?

- All nominations for Job Delegates are signed by the Organiser.
- Nominee and Nominators are checked to see if all are financial members.
- You are formally notified of your endorsement as a Job Delegate and you will receive a formal letter and a Job Delegate Kit.

NOTE:

- There may be more than one Job Delegate in a workplace and in large workplaces this is essential, particularly where there is more than one facility or a number of discrete work units.
- In some cases where there are several nominations and there is a need to limit the number of Job Delegates, an election will be required. In this case the Organiser should be contacted for advice and assistance with the conduct of an election within that work unit.

- If you move workplace location, your JD position can be re-nominated in your new area. Your original JD nomination will cease. Email info@anmfnt.org.au
