

CHURCH SCHOOL AND YOUTH MINISTRIES

Lesson for the Day

The Mustard Seed

Preschool - Rm 221 (age 3 to Kindergarten)

Catechists will present to children the parable of the Mustard Seed (Matthew 13:31-32), reflecting on how God makes great things from the very smallest of things and how the Kingdom of Heaven grows in mysterious ways from small to great.

Lower Elementary - Rm 215 (grades 1 to 3)

Today we will revisit a favorite parable from Level I: The Mustard Seed. Building on what they already know about the parable, we will explore the significance of the rapid growth of the mustard seed into a shrub in the midst of difficult circumstances.

Upper Elementary/middle school - Rm 217 (grades 4 thru 7)

This Sunday children will continue their exploration of the narratives surrounding the life of Abraham and the covenant God made with him. We will be taking a closer look at God's promise to give Abraham and Sarah a son and Abraham's faith in that covenant.

Confirmation-Youth Cottage

This week our confirmands will offer presentations to their peers on various world religions. As they enter into their last month of preparation before Confirmation on 2/6/22 this exercise will help them further clarify what is so compelling about their own faith in the Episcopal Church. Confirmands are encouraged to continue thinking about who they would like to serve as their "sponsor."
