# New Foyer Groups in the New Year?

Whether you're a long-time member or a relative newcomer, Foyer Groups are designed to help you acquire more than a nodding acquaintance with more of your fellow parishioners. The small groups (6-8 people) are formed from all parishioners who sign up. As we begin to emerge from the relative seclusion of COVID, a number of people have asked about resuming Foyers in January 2022. Typically, Foyer Groups of 8-10 people are formed with a designated "first host," with each group setting its own dates for meeting and its own venues (e.g., a pot luck dinner inside or outside a member's home, a local BYO, a spot in the Parish House, a bowling alley). # Lesson for the Day Advent

# Preschool - Rm 221 (age 3 to Kindergarten)

On this first Sunday in Advent, children will sing and process into the Atrium, changing the color of the cloth on their prayer table to purple and placing on it items such as a purple candle, statue of the Good Shepherd, and Bible.

# Lower Elementary - Rm 215 (grades 1 to 3)

We begin to explore the significance the season of Advent this week as we anticipate the mystery of Christmas. Through the next four weeks we will move toward Bethlehem and arrive at the birth of Jesus. Building on last's week's Chapel discussion on Christ as King and the Holy Family, we shift our focus to the shock and joy felt by the shepherds.

#### Upper Elementary/middle school - Rm 217 (grades 4 thru 7)

The 4th through 7th graders will be learning the Nativity story by rehearsing the Church School Christmas Pageant, to be presented on December 19. There will also be costuming, creation of art work for the program, and other tasks to be organized by the teachers. Everyone – whether able to participate in the pageant or not – has a part!


