
First Sunday of the Month - December 4

DID YOU KNOW

Did you know 217 (and counting) households have already pledged to Stewardship 2023? The wonderful news is the total amount pledged increased by almost 8% which is a tremendous help to offset the rising costs associated with inflation and the decrease in the endowment. 57% of pledges increased, 35% renewed last year's pledge, 2% are new or returned pledges and 6% decreased. The majority of the pledges who increased support were from those who give in the average (\$3,500), median (\$2,500) or below the median range of gifts. CHURCH SCHOOL AND YOUTH MINISTRIES

Lesson of the Day The Adoration of the Shepherds

Preschool - Rm 221 (age 3 to Kindergarten)

In preparation for Christmas, we explore the Nativity story through several lenses to ensure the children internalize the narrative. Today we will hear the story through the vantage point of the shepherds. This angle of the story introduces children to the mystery of the Incarnation as something small leading to greatness and reinforces the events of Christ's birth and life as historical events that took place in time and space.

Lower Elementary - Rm 215 (grades 1 to 3)

We continue to explore the significance the season of Advent as we anticipate the mystery of Christmas. Through the next several weeks we will move toward Bethlehem and arrive at the birth of Jesus. Building on last week's focus on the work of the Prophets in proclaiming the coming of Christ as King, we shift our focus to the shock and joy felt by the shepherds.

Upper School - Rm 217 (grades 4 thru 7)

Today the older kids will be learning the Nativity story by rehearsing the Church School Christmas Pageant, to be presented on December 18. There will also be costuming, creation of art work for the program, and other tasks to be organized by the teachers. Everyone – whether able to participate in the pageant or not – has a part!

Confirmation - Hospitality Suite

In class Sunday, we will begin discussing the Book of Common Prayer. This book is our guide to worship on Sundays and holidays, but also has tons of valuable prayers and other resources for our daily lives as Christians.

Redeemer Youth Group - Youth Cottage

RYG will be meeting this Sunday at the cottage from 4-6 pm. We will begin discussions around advent and the world that Jesus was coming to save. We will consider how different that world is from our world today.
