Did you know the "Final" Stewardship 2024 numbers will be presented at the Annual Meeting on February 4th? A tremendous thank you to all who submitted a pledge, and all who volunteered. Everyone helped make the 2024 campaign a huge success. Collectively, there was an 8% increase in total dollars pledged and the best news is there was also an 8% increase in the number of pledges, which was a result of a significant rise in new pledging members, and returned lapsed members (sybunt). The new and returned pledges outweighed the natural attrition and is an indicator of growth for the Church. Thank you to all for the good Stewardship news that will be shared at the Annual Meeting, and will make a significant difference for our church community throughout the year.
