

Redeemer Hosting Alternative Spring Break Groups

These groups appreciate the hospitality of The Redeemer community as they make the Parish House their base for exploring a range of nonprofit organizations and communities in Philadelphia and the region.

Looking for a Lenten Discipline

How about saying Compline on Zoom with fellow parishioners?

Compline is a service of evening prayers forming part of the Divine Office of the Western Christian Church, traditionally said (or chanted) before retiring for the night. The groups are using a new liturgy for Lent. You can join the group on Tuesdays and Thursdays at 9:00pm and on Sundays at 8:00pm. DID YOU KNOW

Did you know, Main Line Meals on Wheels (MLMOW), which receives support from Redeemer's Community Connections, delivered over 68,000 meals in 2025? 56% of the program's patrons receive subsidies because they fall under HUD's definition of low income or extremely low income. Since 1972 MLOW mission is "to deliver nutritious meals to the aged, convalescents, homebound and handicapped persons who are unable to shop or cook for themselves, regardless of race, color, creed or ability to pay". The number of patrons who receive subsidies doubled in the past five years. The program is independently funded and able to keep costs low (\$8.50/day for a bagged lunch, hot soup and hot meal) due to the commitment of volunteers who gave 12,000 hours and drove 50,000 miles last year. The program also provides brief daily check-ins and connections for patrons who want socialization.
