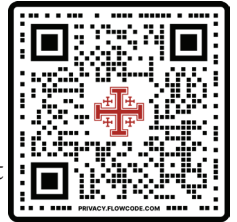

It is also responsible for more than thirty institutions, including hospitals, schools, clinics, centers for children with disabilities, rehabilitation centers, guesthouses, and retirement homes, which are transforming lives of the vulnerable and displaced in the Middle East. Archbishop Hosam oversees all of these parishes and institutions, which are scattered across five separate countries or territories: Jordan, Palestine, Lebanon, Syria, and Israel.
