

 - Proceed with Construction August 2019























Construction Budget

- \$9M Construction Budget
 - Based on 2 reconciled schematic estimates and Design/Development Plans
 - Escalation based on starting in Q3 of 2019
- \$3M Other Construction Costs
 - Professional Fees
 - Hazardous Material Abatement
 - Construction Contingencies
 - Fixtures, Furnishings & Equipment
 - Moving and Temporary Facility Costs
- \$12M Total Project Costs





Relocation Committee and Process

June - February 2019:

- Coordinate with Township and complete specifications, design, budget for temporary space
- Identify materials for storage and relocation

October 2018 - April 2019:

- Bidding of relocation storage efforts
- Selection of temporary meeting space provider

January - June 2019 :

- Cleansing of unneeded materials, pack up and storage of essentials
- Delivery and installation of temporary meeting space
- Preparation of 211 Pennswood for office space

July 2019:

 Complete transfer of all necessary equipment and materials and staff to temporary meeting space and 211 Pennswood.

August 2019:

Turn over Parish House to Contractor

October 2020:

Relocate to new Parish House
