DDA ~ DOWNTOWN Development Authority

Authority ~ On the authority of the State of MI and Portland City Council, the DDA (MiPortland) Board of Directors (including the Executive Director) works together to serve the District. In Portland, our DDA District extends the commercial corridors of Grand River Ave, Water St NW, and includes Historic Downtown.

TIF ~ TAX INCREMENT FINANCING. The DDA is funded by an INCRE-MENT (3.7%) of the property tax dollars captured within it's district TIF PLAN ~ developed with community input and adhering to DDA TIF laws & guidelines, the TIF Plan is the guiding document that outlines how these taxpayer dollars can be spent.

The majority of TIF \$ are collected along Grand River Ave, and Water Street. The majority of these funds (intended to benefit all) are spent in the small Historic Downtown area. The main focus is to utilize tax dollars to prevent deterioration and set the stage for economic growth. Permitted for construction, renovation, repair, remodeling and rehabilitation of public facilities and multi family dwellings withing the district.
