"Riccardo and Halina Biella started the business in Ionia in 2002," said Cathey. "They opened the Portland location 2016."

As a family-owned business, Olivera's promotes a family culture among its employees and customers. "We are a tight -knit organization," said Cathey. "We regard our staff as our own family. Owners and managers are very involved in helping our staff to grow personally and professionally. Because of this, we have been able to avoid the high level of employee turnover that is typical of the restaurant industry."

Olivera's specializes in Italian recipes but it also features other offerings including American and Mexican dishes. "Olivera's has something for everyone, said Cathey, offering a variety of price ranges along with new weekly specials that allow people to try something different. This gives our kitchen an outlet for creativity and it gives our regular customers a variety of choices."

Olivera's is very involved in promoting Portland. "We are active in the community," said Cathey. "We donate funds to various local organizations and we volunteer for local causes. For Easter Sunday 2020 we utilized volunteers from both of our locations to prepare Easter dinners which we gave to whomever needed them—no questions asked. We did this because we knew that the pandemic had adversely affected people and we want to do what we can to help. This is representative of the family culture that we strive to promote."

Olivera's is thankful for the opportunity to be in Portland. "We are grateful to be in Portland and of how the community has supported us," said Cathey. "We seek to strengthen our relationships here as we plan to serve the community for many years to come."
