

It felt inevitable that the visitors would find a breakthrough – Martins missed a couple of presentable opportunities, Valero with a couple of fine saves – but the goal finally came on the half-hour in the cruellest fashion, a shot Ryan CLUETT heading wide of the far post but it struck Rossi and was diverted in for an own goal. Within four, Brock could have been level, a brilliant run from Holmes sending Bent in on goal and his shot beat Lee but came back off the post and away. Small margins...

Hard to argue with the half-time score in all honesty, Stoneham had just about been the better side but no reason for Badgers fans to be despondent. Within four minutes of the restart, Holmes had slalomed his way past four defenders before shooting just wide from the edge of the box.

Another spell of Stoneham pressure, resisted – and then one of those avoidable moments, Valero with a careless clearance straight to Martins, excellent block from Macfarlane but the ball rolled loose to Tyrrell SAMPSON and he finished into the roof of the net, 0-2.

But the current Badgers are resilient. 64 minutes, livewire Freddie Beale with another super run down the right, pulled back to Bent, shot blocked but turned home by Luke HOLMES at the back post to give Brock a lifeline. 12 minutes from time, star man Luke Holmes, the ball sticking to his foot like a magnet, knocked over in a tackle but getting up and going again, chipping a cross to the back post, Dylan WALKER rising high above everyone, perfect header back across goal and in to level things up. Valero gave the visitors a chance to retake the lead when he cleared straight to Sampson, but Rossi made an excellent interception — and from the resulting corner, Dyer headed goalwards but caught by Valero just under the bar.

Time now running out... three minutes to go... another Brock attack, the ball blocked, half-cleared towards the edge of the area, returned on the volley with interest by WALKER, smashing home his second and Brock's third. Cue pandemonium on the pitch and in the stands! Now, were the Badgers going to be able to hold on? Somehow, yes: right on 90 minutes, a Stoneham free kick caused mayhem in the area, Miller couldn't quite get a touch, ball recycled from the byline and to be honest I'm not quite sure how it ended up in Valero's grateful arms, so many bodies and so many legs swinging at it five yards out.

Even then, time for a free kick from Fee, brilliantly turned away by Valero, the last meaningful action of a highly entertaining match.

### **M27 TEN DAY CLOSURE**

In case you missed it last week, if you're planning on travelling on the M27 over Christmas, then forward planning is advised. The M27 motorway will be closed completely, in both directions, between Junctions 9 (Whiteley) and 11 (Fareham), from 20:00, 24 December 2025 to 04:00, on Sunday 4 January 2026. The closure is required to put in place a new four-lane wide underpass beneath the M27, using an innovative 'box slide' engineering technique. Using this method means that many months of lane restrictions, speed limits, and overnight works can be avoided.

The giant pre-constructed concrete structure - weighing approximately 8,500 tonnes (2.5 times heavier than HMS Victory) - will be slid 65 metres into a deep trench cut into the motorway embankment, from its current construction location on the north of the motorway.

The motorway will then be fully reconstructed above it.

### Key information road users need to know during the closure period:

There will be a signed diversion route in place along the A27, which is mostly two lanes in each direction, during the closure. This route is expected to be busy, particularly between 10:00 and 16:00 every day when drivers should be prepared for extended delays. Road users should aim to plan their journey in advance and consider alternatives including public transport, travelling during less busy times, using different routes, or considering if their journey is really necessary.

Drivers will be able to exit the M27 westbound at Junction 11 for Fareham and Gosport, and eastbound at Junction 9 for Whiteley and Park Gate. However, there will be no westbound entry to the M27 at Junction 11 for traffic heading towards Southampton or the A32 (Alton), and no eastbound entry at Junction 9 for traffic heading towards Portsmouth.
