COMING UP?

Last week we listed the Clubs across the Country who have applied for promotion to Step Six for next season, The list was as at December 19th and applications are accepted by the FA up until the 31st, but given the time of year the likelihood of any further applications is probably minimal. Of the 44 applications received to date just four probably come into the Velocity Wessex League area – Blandford United, Bournemouth Sports, Hedge End Rangers and Shrewton United – so a look at those in greater detail.

BLANDFORD UNITED have been members of the Dorset Premier League in its various incarnations since the 1960's and were Champions in both 1983 and 1992. They have been in the top five in each of the last three seasons and currently occupy third place in the table with 45 points from 17 games. It is a long time since the writer visited their ground in Park Road in the town but memory suggests it will be of the standard required for the step up, with covered standing being added to the site in recent seasons..

BOURNEMOUTH SPORTS are the current Dorset Premier League Champions and are in sixth place in the current table with 33 points from 18 games and perhaps have a little to do in the second half of the season. They play at the BU Sports Campus at Chapel Gate in Bournemouth.

HEDGE END RANGERS are the most local of the applicants and apart from a short break have been involved with the Hampshire Premier League since 2011/12, and have finished in second and fifth places in the last two seasons. At present in seventh spot with 26 points from 17 games and, like Bournemouth Sports, may have to raise their game in the second part of the season. Should they gain promotion they will ground share with Sholing.

SHREWTON UNITED are the last of the four, purely because of alphabetical order, and are currently members of the Wiltshire Senior League and at present top the table. They have made applications in the past and invariably withdrawn same, but the Club is in a much better place now, both on and off the field, and hopefully in a position to let the application stand. The Shrews have experience in the FA Vase, albeit not since 2012/13, when they went down 4-0 at home against Cadbury Heath in the First Round Qualifying. Shrewton is less than ten miles from Amesbury and perhaps better suited to joining our family rather than the Western but it will be all down to the FA!

Not heard of any additional clubs as we go to press, although there have been some rumours.

THREE wins out of four had put 9th placed Hamworthy United in sight of the play-off places, but they could ill afford any slip ups at the Mettal Stadium. This interestingly is the venue of their first ever Wessex League away game back in 2004, against Thatcham. Aldermaston though had won their last two games so could not be taken lightly. With Bailey Rowe on his travels, Josh Taylor became the pivotal striker playing just in front of Sam Darlow. Noah Crisp returned in goal having now recovered from a training injury. IT was first v second at Stoneham Lane today, as The Purps hosted The Rams in front of a bumper crowd of 180. A wonderfully crisp winter's day provided the perfect setting, even if it did get a little chilly after the sun went down. The teams were only separated by goal difference going in to the match, with Stoneham looking to make it a home and away double over Petersfield this season. "Cagey" was the word that best describes how the game started, and indeed was appropriate for the first half as a whole.

After a few penalty misses of late by various Stoneham players, Jake THOMSON took the ball and with a calm certainty placed the ball to the keepers left.
