LOOKING UP FOR 2026/27

Please find below a list of the Current Clubs that have applied for promotion to Step 6 from their Regional Feeder League as supplied by the FA. This list is accurate as at the closing date for applications-Wednesday 31 December. The next steps will see the Football Foundation arranging Stadium Accreditation Inspections with the applying clubs where required, and leagues may be contacted to attend these as well, the FA are also currently assessing the applications against the requirements within the NLS Regulations and contacting clubs where required.

In order to be considered for promotion Clubs must finish in first position in their Feeder League. If the Club finishing in first position does not wish to be promoted or fails to meet the entry criteria then the Club finishing in second position will be eligible for promotion. If the Club in second position does not seek promotion or fails to meet the entry criteria then Clubs down to fifth position may be considered for promotion provided that they meet the appropriate entry criteria. Clubs finishing below fifth position may not be considered for promotion and only one Club may be considered for promotion from each League.

Since the first list- in Wessex Poist #26 was released the number of applicants has swollen to 118. Our first table shows the applicants from the 44 leagues that have seen a club apply.
