

THIS match had already been postponed twice for wind and rain, so huge credit to the Sherborne volunteers for getting the pitch into such good condition for the third attempt – flooding may have prevented most of the Brock massive from reaching the venue, but once there you'd barely have known it had rained! An important game for both sides too ... the Zebras hadn't actually played a league game since 27 December, over a month ago, with just one cup outing against Weymouth a fortnight ago.

Four days on; different worlds. Brockenhurst were back on song, and were very comfortable winners; indeed they might have been disappointed not to have won by more than a couple of goals. In the first half, in particular, they were dominant – Toby Bailey and Toby Colmer running the midfield, Freddie Beale zipping down the flanks, Andriy Demira settling into his midfield role as if he'd been in the team all season. A third goal might have followed, clever through-ball to Dunesby-Bent, brilliantly intercepted by Mapletoft just in time.

The Badgers should probably have put the game to bed early in the second half, but the final shot was tame or the final ball not quite accurate enough. ## IN AND OUT

With the season just past its halfway point some early thoughts perhaps regarding any possible changes in personnel when the League Constitutions are formulated for 2026/27.

We have already made mention recently of the Clubs from Step Seven who have applied for promotion and could fit within the League boundaries, but relegation from the Leagues above also has to come into consideration - those in question being the Southern Division One (South) and the Isthmian League South Central Division. In the first named BASHLEY have a lot to do as at present they are in the bottom four, seven points from safety and with just 16 points, four wins and nineteen goals to their name. Their four-year stay at that level is in serious danger of ending. On the other side of the coin, so to speak, Shaftesbury are in the playoff places in only their second season at the higher level.

On to the Isthmian, and, as this is written, the bottom two places are filled by HORNDEAN and FAREHAM TOWN. The Deans have 22 points and, assuming four Clubs are relegated, are four points from safety, but Fareham's plight is verging on perilous. They have just eleven points and two wins and are sixteen points adrift. Add to these their current pitch problems and sadly their stay at the higher level could be just one season.

Final mention here is that both Moneyfields and AFC Portchester are vying for a play-off place.

For the purpose of this exercise, we should add that the League will lose two Clubs through promotion. AFC Stoneham look a certainty and deserve to go up if they satisfy the criteria whilst at present Hamble Club, Petersfield Town, Portland United and Laverstock & Ford are in contention for the second spot. Taking things into consideration perhaps Portland are the best placed on and off the pitch to get there.

Going back to where we started with Clubs coming up from Step Seven, there may be three teams relegated from the Wessex League Division One with the bottom three at present being – in ascending order – Totton & Eling, Fawley and Lymington Town. The Millers have the most games left to play with the vast majority being at home (*which will test their pitch and the pencil of the Fixtures Secretary*) whilst Lymington's fall from the Southern League to their present position has been somewhat rapid.

One further complication to all the above is the possibility of what the FA term lateral movement where Clubs are moved sideways to another League. And finally mention of a former Wessex League Club outside all of the above. In 2017/18 Andover Town won promotion to the Southern League, inexplicably turned it down, and were relegated instead. Since then the Club has been on a seemingly unchecked downward path and are at present bottom of the Hampshire Premier League and facing yet another relegation.
