ALRESFORD Town travelled to the AEC Protection Ground to face a strong Romsey Town Tuesday evening, on the back of a resolute defensive performance the previous Saturday against high flying Whitchurch United which resulted in a 1-0 win. McCulloch, Harvey Welch and Locke were pulling more strings than Pinocchio's puppet master, and on 36 minutes the ball was in the back of Romsey Town's net, again link up play between Brennan and McCulloch seeing Jack Welch side footing home from close range, only to see the linesman's flag raised for offside.
