SATURDAY 25 APRIL

DIVISION ONE- Folland Sports 3-3 Hamworthy United

Tony Beck was pitchside

THE Planemakers had been flying well of late, and needed just a point to guarantee a second place finish, and with it arguably a more comfortable play-off semi-final. Unpredictable Hamworthy United made two changes from midweek. Louis Whetton and Ryan Chavez-Munoz were both deservedly given leave of absence to cheer on the Saints on at Wembley. Replacing them were Ollie Wilson, helping out on loan from Holt United who had no game, and Pietro Almeida. Wilson's Holt teammate Reece Mitchell continued in goal with Noah Crisp still nursing a knock.

It was the hosts carrying the very early threat, with away stopper Reece Mitchell doing very well to push one knocked down header from a corner up and over the bar. Another free header from a corner also just missed the bar.

It was the Hammers though who drew first blood on eight minutes. Sam Darlow, having completed some good work on the right, sent in a low cross to the left of goal, which Pietro ALMEIDA controlled well before firing an unstoppable volley into the far corner.

The hosts reacted well, another corner on 18 minutes being headed this time straight into the midriff of Mitchell. They were deservedly back on terms on 25 minutes. A slick three-man move from midfield, coupled with a poor touch off a United defender, ended with the ball falling to their dangerman Charlie GLASSPOOL. He duly fired low into the bottom left corner.

Towards the end of the half, it was the Hammers now taking the initiative, but were unable to put away a number of good chances with home keeper Theo Widger pulling off some fine stops. Their closest effort came on 42 minutes when Bailey Rowe's low cross from the left was put just wide by an unmarked Sam Darlow at the near post, curiously on his weaker right foot.

Both teams had early chances after the break, but it was United who were back in front on 54 minutes. Ollie Woolley showed good determination to win the ball back before setting up Pietro ALMEIDA who showed neat footwork before his excellent finish from 20 yards found the bottom corner.

Given their propensity all season to concede late goals, the Hammers would no doubt have been relieved to net again on 70 minutes. This was with no small debt to Jamie Ross's fine run, before cutting back inside, and dinking a telling ball to Bailey ROWE over his defender. The United striker went on the lob the ball delicately over the keeper.

It was though to be a nervy finish for the Hammers as the Planemakers pulled it back to 2-3 in the 88th minute. This was when substitute Josh Perry's deep free kick from the right was met by a free header at the far post from substitute Joe SMITH.

There was an unnerving sense from the Hammers' bench that a late Folland equaliser was coming, and par for the course, did so four minutes into injury time. The busy Mitchell had already done well to beat out an angled shot at his near post. Clayd Roach's teasing corner from the left seemed to brush a number of heads. The final touch by Joe SMITH was controversially adjudged to have crossed the line before Jack Kinge-Phillips hooked the ball away. The film evidence when it comes will be most interesting.

There was barely time for the restart, leaving the Hammers having to again reflect on points dropped late on. They should not be too downhearted though. They had contributed to a fine game of football, and most would have accepted one point at start of play, the Planemakers having amassed 16 goals in their previous two games.
