**ISUZU FA VASE FINAL- AFC Stoneham 0-0 Cockfosters (4-2 on penalties)**

Wessex League champions AFC Stoneham ended an incredible season by lifting the FA Vase at Wembley following a tense 4-2 penalty shootout victory over Cockfosters. Cockfosters Junior Moses lifted his side's fourth spot-kick high over the bar to trigger an outburst of emotion from the Stoneham players and staff in front of their purple army of fans.

Two hours earlier, Stoneham's captain Alex Welch and his Cockfosters counterpart, Jay Lovell, had introduced their sides to FA Chair Debbie Hewitt under grey north London skies.

Stoneham put out a full-strength side whilst Cockfosters made two changes from their Spartan South Midlands League play-off defeat to Winslow United.

The sun briefly came out as Cockfosters, all in red, kicked off, playing towards the east end of the stadium. After Stoneham had forced the first corner two minutes in, Cockfosters had the first real chance when centre-forward Kendall Gyamfi headed narrowly wide. It then became an even game with defences on top and few clear-cut chances (which set the pattern for the rest of the match).

Purps' Tyrrell Sampson looked to create an opportunity when he cut inside after 26 minutes but the Cockfosters defence snuffed it out. And it was Fosters' own number 9, the pacey Gyamfi, who burst clear through on goal seven minutes later but widely-experienced centre-back Dan Miller used all his nous to harry Gyamfi into merely touching the ball into the hands of Stoneham keeper Callum Lee.

After Fosters skipper Lovell had received the game's first booking, Stoneham created their own best chance of the half after 40 minutes when Duarte Martins headed a ballooned Cockfosters clearance over the bar.

As the second half began, Sampson was still causing Cockfosters problems but it was his opposite number who had his team's best chance of the afternoon in the 47th minute. Lee could only punch clear a corner and Gyamfi headed the ball onto the crossbar. Only two minutes later a cross from Cory Ugbomah narrowly evaded the same player. Cockfosters looked to be in the ascendancy with Junior Mubiayi blasting over from 20 yards.

As the hour mark approach, Stoneham began to come back into the game. Tom Annetts fired over after Sampson pulled the ball back to him and after Ugbomah had been booked for a foul on Lewis Nagle, Miller headed over the bar from the resulting free-kick.

And the Purps went even closer on 65 minutes. Martins headed against the bar from a corner and Nagle's fierce follow-up shot was deflected wide by his own player, Mat Bainbridge. Annetts then had a shot deflected over the bar.

Stoneham substitute Owen Fee began to play a part in the game as his side ended the stronger, just failing to connect with a low cross and then setting up man of the match Nagle for a close-range shot which was well saved by Cockfosters goalkeeper Connor Salmon at his near post.

Stoneham made a raft of substitutions in the closing stages to ensure, as manager James Phillips explained after the match, that they had fresh legs for the spot-kick finale, should it go beyond his designated top five takers.

Cockfosters had a final good break on 88 minutes but with no end product and Purps' Ash Wells went into referee Elliot Bell's notebook but after six added minutes the game finished goalless and went to penalties.

Clubs have one vote each and should be represented by the Chairman, Secretary and Team Manager or their deputies, plus an optional additional Club Representative is allowed to attend if required.

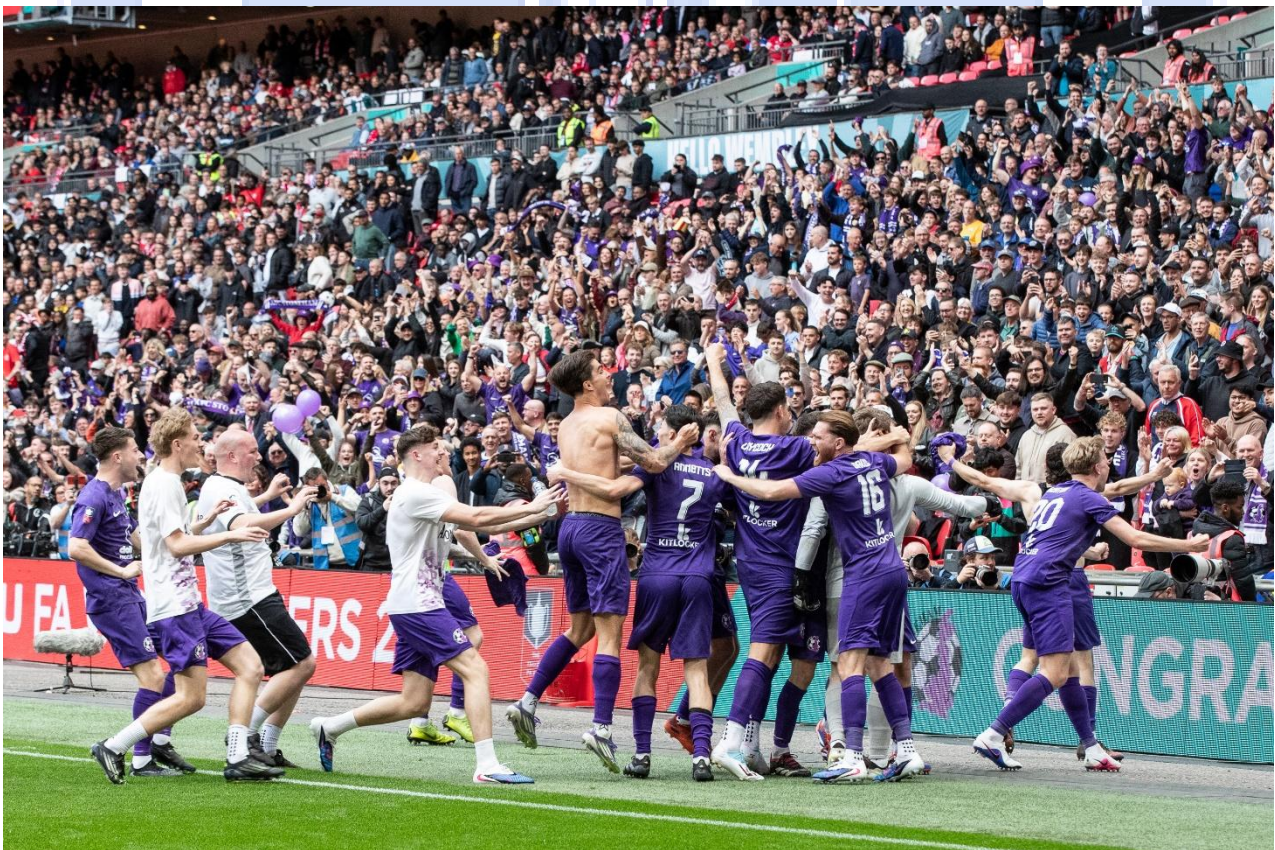
