One of the more unusual approaches to a ground, as you drive up a very small lane and then through a play-park to get there. 76 people were enjoying a warm evening, and I remember being told by one of the committee that they hadn't had a drop of rain there for something like three months. - The competition was not played between 1915 and 1919. It was also not played in 2021 due to a pandemic.
- An asterisk (\*) against the year denotes trophy shared.
- The club name shown is the last title used in a final but bracketed *italic type* shows a different club name used for a previous cup final appearance (where applicable).
- // denotes significant years to differentiate merged teams (eg Havant Town and Waterlooville are both in the table prior to a merger) or a club that was reformed, such as Aldershot FC and Farnborough Town FC who won the cup but folded and were replaced by new clubs.
- Note that some clubs may not have used their strongest teams in the final (eg Southampton 'A' won the cup in 1976) but it is the overall club record that is shown. (+ previously as Bournemouth & Boscombe Athletic)

## STURMINSTER NEWTON UNITED

In 1874 the club, which was then known as the Panthers FC, became the first ever club from the West Country to participate in the FA Cup, reaching the second round on three occasions.

In 1877/78 they played the legendary Wanderers in the first round but lost 9-1.

In the 1890's their name was changed to Sturminster St Mary's, with the current name adopted in 1945.

They were among the founding members of the Dorset Combination in 1957, having previously played in the Dorset League. After leaving the league due to financial difficulties in 1960, they played in the lower Dorset Senior League until they re-joined the Combination in 1972. They remained in that competition (since 2002 known as the Dorset Premier League) until 2011, when they were relegated to the Dorset Senior League. During this time, they won the Combination Cup twice, in 1981 and 1995.

They moved from a public recreation ground to their own stadium in Honeymead Lane in 1996.

In 2011/12 under Gary Head, in his first full season in charge, the club won the Dorset Senior Trophy with a 1-0 win over Parley Sports at Wimborne Town.

In 2021/22 under the management of Nick Squires the club won its second Dorset Senior Trophy, beating Merley Cobham Sports 2-1 at The County Ground, Hamworthy.

In 2022/23 the club continued their success adding the Dorset Premier League Cup to the trophy cabinet beating Sturminster Marshall 4-1 at Wimborne Town.

The 2023/24 season was one of the most successful in the history of the club as they won the Dorset Premier League for the first time and gained promotion to Step 6.

The 2024/25 season exceeded their wildest dreams. Although not everything went their way on the pitch, overall it was a terrific season with manager Nick Squires leading the club to eighth position just a few points behind the play off places.

The 2025/26 season saw more history being made. Finishing second in Division One of the Western League, the Cherries secured promotion to Step 5 through the play offs and will play Wessex League football in 2026/27.
