With some new and important initiatives coming soon from the FA regarding the development of Clubs, the League has appointed Giles Kilshawe-Fall to fill the role of Development Officer.

FA COMPETITIONS

The FA released the lists for acceptances to the FA Cup, the FA Trophy, FA Vase and FA Youth Cup competitions yesterday.

In the FA Cup, as expected all our premier Division sides have been accepted. There are 743 entrants in the 2026/27 competition.

There will be 123 Step 4 Clubs that are not exempt to the Preliminary Round and will instead enter the Competition in the Extra Preliminary Round. These Clubs will be the 32 newly promoted Clubs from Step 5 and also the 91 lowest ranked Step 4 Clubs not relegated.

The 91 lowest ranked Step 4 Clubs shall comprise of 12 Clubs from three of the eight Step 4 Leagues and 11 Clubs from the five remaining Step 4 Leagues, from season 2025-26.

In the FA Vase there are 601 acceptances, 40 of our teams are in the hat. Sadly two of our teams were not on the list- Alresford Town and Lymington Town.
