
MEET DR. BERNARD W. LYNCH

That whitish film that builds up on your teeth is called plaque and it is the number one reason for tooth decay. The acidic substance eats away at your tooth enamel and if not stopped, will lead to

cavities. The way to remove this plaque is by brushing, flossing and having your teeth cleaned at your dentist office.

STOP TOOTH LOSS

Cavities are just the first symptoms you will suffer from the build-up of plaque, you could also suffer gum disease. As the gum disease advances, plaque moves farther down the tooth where it can begin to destroy actual bone. This is not something you want to suffer from.


FRESH BREATH

If you've been neglecting your dental health out of fear of pain, Sedation Dentistry offers you the opportunity to safely receive dental treatments free of fear and pain.

At the office of Dr. Lynch, your well-being is our priority. We specialize in Sedation Dentistry and Sleep Dentistry to ensure that your visit is comfortable and painless. We treat people with dental phobias and anxieties, as well as people who just opt to bypass possible discomforts during certain procedures. An unpleasant memory from your childhood of pain or of an unprofessional dental practitioner can stand as a barrier to you getting the dental treatment you need or want.

We offer two types of Sedation Dentistry. These include administering oral sedation, in the form of a pill, as well as intravenous sedation to deliver a combination of drugs. All this depends on the needs and health of the patient. You will receive just enough sedation so that you will be completely unaware of the treatment, as you would if you were asleep.

ORAL DENTAL SEDATION

Sedation Dentistry can be administered orally through prescription by Dr. Bernard Lynch. While patients feel like they are sleeping, they are actually fully awake and maintain complete control over body functions and breathing rate. You are given oral medication about one

hour before your appointment. The medicine safely puts you in a light state of sedation and you sleep through your dental appointment. When you awaken your dental treatment is completed.

INTRAVENOUS SEDATION

Intravenous (IV) sedation is a popular option for patients with extreme dental anxiety. This is a medication that is administered directly through the blood stream. With Sedation Dentistry, patients experience immediate relaxation and comfort. An anesthesiologist comes to Dr. Lynch's office to administer the IV sedation. This ensures that the Sedation Dentistry is safe and effective.

With either oral or IV sedation, you will need someone to drive you to and from your appointment. Before your treatment you can rest comfortably in a quiet space under a cozy blanket. Throughout the duration of your visit, we closely monitor you to ensure your safety.

WHO CAN BENEFIT FROM **DENTAL SEDATION?**

Adults who have:

- anxiety or fear of visiting the dentist
- ... had traumatic dental experiences
- ... difficulty getting numb
- ... who gag easily
- ... very sensitive teeth
- ... complex dental problems that require lengthy appointments

As well, Sedation Dentistry is an option for adults who:

- ... hate needles and shots
- ... hate the noises, smells and tastes associated with the dental office
- are afraid and embarrassed about their teeth.

About 90% of the patients who have gone through Sedation Dentistry at our office were given simple oral sedatives. Using oral sedation is a simple, and easy approach to helping a patient get through their dental treatment. Recovery is quick afterwards, so you can usually go about your day without the heavy aftereffects of other forms of sedation. Oral sedation is the usual method of relieving the fear and anxiety of dental treatments. There are, however even deeper levels of sedation, such as IV and general anesthesia, both of which we can perform at our office, safely and effectively.

Sedation allows our patients to relax, and have the care they need much more easily. The first step is for you to come in for a consultation. You would meet the doctor and he will discuss with you the options available, any past experiences you've had, as well as the level of fear or anxiety you have towards the dentist and dentistry, and together you would figure out how best to proceed with your treatment and what type of sedation is necessary or wanted. We want you to feel relaxed, comfortable and happy at the end of your treatment, and Sedation Dentistry can, and has worked to just those ends. If the fear of dentistry, past bad experiences, or general nervousness about receiving treatment has prevented you from getting the care that you need, come in for a consultation with the doctor at one of our warm and welcoming offices, where you'll find premium Sedation Dentistry in Northern VA. Our caring and understanding dentist and staff will work with you to achieve the smile that you deserve.

Dr. Lynch, for instance, may use a laser instead of a drill to prepare a tooth for a filling or during root canal treatment. He might also use laser therapy for implants, oral surgery, teeth-whitening and treating sleep apnea. And he may use another type of laser for pain management.

With dental lasers, there is no drilling, no scalpels and no anesthetics all of which provide a much pleasanter patient experience.

IMMEDIATE SNORING RELIEF

WHAT CAUSES SNORING?

When you sleep, your throat muscles relax and push into the airway. Your tongue, also relaxed, may fall back, further constricting your airway. When you breathe, air traveling over these obstructions creates the harsh sounds of snoring. To prevent snoring, the airway must be kept open during sleep.

Dr. Lynch is specially trained in administering Nigthlase Snoring Treatment. Using the state-of-the-art NightLase® laser, he gently and safely tightens the airway muscles to prevent them from blocking the airway during sleep. When the airway is clear, snoring

Dr. Lynch treats gum disease with his TwinLight[™] laser system by rapidly removing infected gum tissue and cleaning bacteria and tartar from the teeth roots under the gumline. It's fast and extremely effective in reversing gum disease.


ENHANCING A GUMMY SMILE

WHAT IS TMJ?

TMJ is an abbreviation for "temporomandibular joint" that's the joint which connects your lower jaw to your skull.

The TMJ is a complex joint which works with your muscles so you can move your jaw in multiple directions. A small piece of cartilage (soft tissue) above the joint protects it from rubbing directly against the temple bone. It also enables smooth movements of the TMJ. When something goes wrong with the TMJ, it causes the symptoms above and others.

CAUSES OF TMD PROBLEMS

Problems with the TMJ are referred to as "temporomandibular joint disorders" or TMD for short.

TMD typically occurs when the patient's bite is misaligned or the protective cartilage slips out of place due to an injury to the head or neck. Other TMD causes include chronic grinding or clenching of the teeth and arthritis.

HOW DR. LYNCH TREATS TMJ PROBLEMS

Ninety percent of TMJ pain is related to the muscles, particularly those used for chewing. Dr. Lynch thoroughly examines your bite and may measure your muscle activity using an advanced technique called "electromyography." This is an electronic diagnostic technique which Dr. Lynch performs using a delicate instrument to precisely record and evaluate muscle activity related to your bite. With this technical information, Dr. Lynch can then successfully address your TMD.

By aligning a patient's bite, Dr. Lynch has eliminated headaches, including migraines and pain in the neck, back and shoulders. He has also reduced clenching and grinding and even relieved snoring to improve sleep.

Your bite—the way your upper and lower teeth fit together—has a large effect on your health and well-being. Here are five reasons to get your bite checked and make sure it is properly aligned:

- 1. Prevent teeth from cracking or breaking

- 3. Chew food properly for maximum nutrients
- 4. Breathe through your nose (a misaligned bite can cause mouth-breathing)





SMILE DESIGN

Bernard W. Lynch, DMD, FAGD, LVIF is an artist when it comes to cosmetic dentistry. Not only does he create beautiful, attractive smiles, he designs smiles that naturally integrate with a person's physical characteristics.

Dr. Lynch is clinically trained in Digital Smile Design; a new technology that actually enables patients to visualize and effectively "test-drive" their individually tailored cosmetic dental mock-up before finalizing the completed result.

DIGITAL SMILE DESIGN PROCESS

STEP 1 - COMPREHENSIVE **EVALUATION**

The first step in smile design is a comprehensive evaluation. Dr. Lynch will conduct a physical examination to inspect the patient's teeth, gums, jaw joints and muscles, looking for signs of decay, stress, or instability. Any problems should be corrected prior to having Digital Smile Design because those same problems are likely to recur if they are simply masked with dental work. Additionally, he studies a patient's facial appearance, including the symmetry of features, size of the lips and mouth, and



skin tone and texture to make sure that the cosmetic changes will look natural. Digital photos and video are taken of the teeth and entire mouth from multiple angles. As well, Dr. Lynch takes diagnostic scans and x-rays of the teeth to aid in the next step, treatment planning.

STEP 2 - TREATMENT PLANNING

Dr. Lynch will create a 2-D design, which is mocked up from using all the information gathered in Step 1. From there, the design is calibrated to the patient in order to build a 3-D model, which demonstrates and test how the changes will function.

STEP 3 - PREPARATION AND PROTOTYPE

Once the planning is complete, both Dr. Lynch and the patient review the photos and videos taken in Step 1. Once they have agreed on the treatment course, the patient's teeth and mouth will begin to be prepped for the restoration and a provisional (a temporary mock up) is created which will begin to duplicate the anticipated results. Molds are taken after the teeth have been prepared, then Dr. Lynch applies a prototype— which is a tooth-colored plastic version of the final restoration. 

Dr. Lynch can offer porcelain veneers or Lumineers, a thinner shell covering the teeth to be treated.

There are advantages unique to each method. Some patients prefer the slightly more natural appearance of the porcelain veneer, but this method will require that a small amount of enamel be removed from the front and tip of the tooth. Numbing will probably be required for this preparation. Lumineers, though, are thinner so only require that the tooth be slightly etched to prepare it for a bond with the veneer. In this case, numbing is not needed.

After a consultation on the enhancement you desire for your smile, Dr. Lynch will advise you on the option that will give you the best result.

For patients who seek cosmetic improvements to their smiles, veneers have so much to offer! In just two weeks for most patients, people who have long been unhappy with severe discoloration, poor spacing or other imperfections can have brand-new, shiny smiles they love to show off.

Veneers are thin, ceramic shells that cover the front and the tip of one or more of your teeth. Here are some of the imperfections veneers can improve:

To replace a missing tooth with an implant, a slender titanium post is first placed in the bone of the jaw. This post will act as the root for the replacement tooth. When the implant has healed well, an attachment is fastened to the top of the implant and your clean, white porcelain replacement tooth—called a crown—is secured to the attachment.

They want to eliminate the unwanted motion of a denture and the need for a sticky adhesive to keep it in place. For these patients, snap-on overdentures are recommended. The supporting implants provide stability for the denture, keeping it from moving around, even while talking or chewing.



WHEN AN **EMERGENCY** STRIKES

For any dental emergency, call the office of Dr. Bernard W. Lynch immediately

for an appointment. The following are some tips on how to handle the emergency until you see Dr. Lynch:

Toothache: Make sure you clean out any food fragments that might be lodged near the tooth. Place a cold pack against the face near the tooth that hurts.

Knocked-out tooth: Only hold a knocked-out tooth by its top—the crown—not by the root. Rinse it with water if dirty. If possible, replace it in the socket immediately, making sure it is facing the right direction. If it's not possible, store the tooth inside your cheek (not recommended for children) or a glass of milk or water to keep it moist. If possible, rush to Dr. Lynch' office to have the tooth restored to its proper place. Fast action is vital to save the tooth.

Broken tooth: Save the tooth fragments. Stop bleeding by applying pressure with gauze or a soft cloth. Place a cold pack on the outside of the face.


Lost filling: If the area is sensitive, cover it with over-the-counter dental cement available at most drug stores.

Lost crown: Apply clove oil to the tooth if it is sensitive. If possible, reposition the crown using only toothpaste or over-the-counter dental cement, never any other kind of glue.

Loosened tooth: Apply cold packs to the outside of the face. Call the office to ask about over-the-counter pain relievers you might use.
