



# **Annual Conference History 2017-2021**

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2-3 March 2017, Brussels, Belgium

During the fifth edition of the 'ACCELERATE Paediatric Oncology Conference', which took place on 2-3 March 2017 in Brussels, participants identified areas of improvement from both successful and unfeasible development plans, learnt about ongoing initiatives to improve paediatric drug development's efficiency, provided original perspectives and engaged in new partnerships to foster innovation.

The meeting was divided into five sections:

- Learning from success and failure in paediatric oncology drug development
- Where are we after 10 years?
- Ongoing initiatives to improve the efficiency of paediatric drug development
- Accelerating
- Investing in paediatric oncology drug development

Now organised on an annual basis, the 2017 ACCELERATE Paediatric Oncology Conference is THE forum where anyone interested in this field can reflect upon and discuss the proposals from the ACCELERATE Platform. On this occasion, participants also evaluated possible changes in the regulatory environment following the 10 years' EMA report on the EU Paediatric Regulation – also comparing with regulatory and policy strategies in the US, Canada, Japan, and Australia – and defined together the next steps forward to give more and better chances of cure to young patients.

6-7 February 2020, Brussels, Belgium

The 8<sup>th</sup> ACCELERATE Paediatric Oncology Conference took place on 6-7 February 2020 in Brussels, Belgium.

Successfully co-organised by SIOP Europe and ITCC, the 8<sup>th</sup> edition of the ACCELERATE Paediatric Oncology Conference was attended by almost 200 participants from 18 countries worldwide. The participants included experts from academia, industry, patient/parent/survivor advocacy groups, foundations and regulatory authorities interested in accelerating new oncology drug development for children and adolescents.

The diverse and high turnout, together with the organisation of the first Paediatric Strategy Forum in the US clearly showed that ACCELERATE has become a truly 'international' organisation. This is a key development in our effort towards accelerating the process of evaluating innovative therapies and introducing them in standard cancer care in children and adolescents.

This year's edition focused on a number of important topics such as:

- New regulatory environment with a focus on the implementation of the Race for Children act;
- Building the assets for preclinical evaluation;
- Latest developments in ACCELERATE: Multi-stakeholder Paediatric Strategy Forums, Fostering Age Inclusive Research (FAIR) trials, Fit-For-Filing academic trials, Long-Term Follow-Up (LTFU), international cooperation;
- New initiatives and business models for accelerating paediatric oncology drug development • Recent successes in paediatric oncology drug development;
