*Since its inception in 1989, the MHSU has performed over 350,000 tests.*

### MHSU Documented Statistics

The Mobile Health Screening Unit documents yearly Statistical information for each test given. This information is computed and reported to Lions and funders .

Each year the unit averages

- 2000 people screened
- 10,000 individual screenings.
- Average failure rate 30%.
- Volunteer hours average 2,500 a year.

## Mobile Health Screening Unit

### Free Screenings

Health screenings are free to the general public.

Testing for critical indicators of more serious issues are detected in about 30% of those individuals tested.

### Tests include:

- Visual Acuity
- Glaucoma/ Tonometry
- Blood Glucose (Diabetes)
- Blood Pressure
- Bone Density
- Lung Capacity
- Body Mass Index
- Cholesterol

## HELPING THE COMMUNITY

Oklahoma currently ranks 48th in the nation in overall health, (according to the United Health Foundation). This number is based on such factors as obesity (Ok is currently ranked 40th), diabetes (43rd), and cardiovascular deaths (48th).

A majority of those tested on the Lions Health unit are rural, underprivileged, elderly, or do not ordinarily seek out medical attention.

On a positive side, a year long survey revealed 60% of those who fail one or more screenings sought medical attention within 30 days. **Saving Lives!**

The unit is available through Oklahoma Lions Club sponsorships in partnership with other non-Lions organizations.

**Sponsoring Lions Clubs pay a program fee of \$100.00** per visit payable to the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation, due at least two weeks prior to the scheduled visit.

The MHSU is 62-1/2 feet long, 11-1/2 feet tall and 8-1/2 feet wide. It does not require an outside electrical source, but has its own generator providing 30-amp 120-volt service for the testing equipment, lights, heater, and or air conditioner.

**Volunteers** - It is extremely important to the success of the program to have an adequate and enthusiastic number of volunteers on hand (8 per shift) when the MHSU is open for screening.

**Certificate of Insurance** — Some parking lots may require a certificate of liability insurance. This insurance is in effect for all Lions and Lion-sponsored events, and the certificate is available free from Lions Clubs International.
