We can accommodate 37 residents across 35 bedrooms, the majority are single en-suite. All are beautifully furnished to a high standard, many with garden views, some with direct patio access.

We invite our residents to bring familiar pieces of furniture with them for their new rooms to make them feel at home.

The Victorian character of the property is evident in some of the communal rooms where we have a number of beautiful spacious lounges, quiet areas, and an elegant dining room. The bright and airy conservatory gives access to a secure patio area.

The property is surrounded by enclosed gardens which offer peace and tranquil surroundings all year round.

Mealtimes are an important social and enjoyable experience for our residents.

All meals are home-cooked by our catering staff using fresh produce. We design our menus to cater for our residents' expressed preferences, dietary and nutritional needs.
