replacing it with a sturdy new block wall. It took seven truckloads and two side-dump trailers to haul away the debris - No Small Feat! The remaining pile of dirt was used to refill behind the new wall. We owe a huge thank-you to both John and Jeff for their tireless work and generosity in donating their time and labor to make this possible. If you see either of them, please take a

moment to thank them for a job well done. The next step will be for the committee to decide on plans for the patio area. We are deeply grateful to our members for their ongoing generosity in supporting this project. We'll know more about any surprises once the cement is removed, but since the wall demolition revealed none, we're staying positive that the patio work will go just as smoothly.
