Shoebox Shortage - We Need Your Help!



Excitement continues for our 4^{th} Street Repair & Refresh project! The new block wall is complete and fully paid for, and work on the cement patio is scheduled to begin in September (after the 7^{th}). We are thankful that the funds are already in place to cover this next portion of the project.

The final step will be repaying the asphalt parking lot. Jeff is working with John Miller to update last year's estimate of about \$44,000. At this time, we don't yet have the funds for this phase.

We are truly grateful for the strong support already shown by our congregation and look forward to reaching this final goal together.
