The committee now has the green light to contract demolition and repairs, with a \$100,000 budget cap.

parking lot improvements, but we'll know more once the wall comes down. Jeff is working with Miller Excavating to finalize the contract and will keep everyone updated.

Today, two beautiful bouquets grace our Altar. The first has been lovingly given by the family of Roger and Dollis Harris in


