4th Street Exterior Repair and Refresh Project Update

This past Thursday, the blacktop was officially laid, and we couldn't be more thrilled to see this vision come to life! We're deeply grateful for the service, prayers, and gifts that made it possible. Handicap parking will be designated in the three spaces directly across from the 4th Street entrance, with new signage installed to clearly mark the area. We've already heard wonderful ideas for how this new patio can be used, and we can't wait to hear more! A working group is currently drafting guidelines and recommendations for furnishings and use, and the Council will make final decisions on the design and use next spring.
