Tim Maybee, previously our seminary intern from 2011-2012 and who now serves as pastor at Amazing Grace, Inver Grove Heights.

What happens to your congregation's mission support?

The gifts our congregation sends to the Saint Paul Area Synod help us to live out the mission of the synod: "As followers of Jesus, we are called to accompany faith communities and equip leaders for God's mission in the world." When we talk about "mission support," we are referring to financial support given by congregations toward the work we do as church together in partnership with over 100 ELCA congregations from Rush City (north) to Rosemount (south). Appearing as an annual line item in our budget, this year's mission support enabled the successful redevelopment of St. Paul Lutheran of Wyoming, Minnesota, support for seminarians and candidates for rostered ministry, and an ethnic-specific mission development, Foundation of Life Church which meets at St. Andrew's in Mahtomedi.

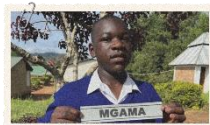
Supporting Students Through Education

pictured in different groups. In Tanzania, government-supported education ends after what is comparable to our sixth grade. For students who wish to continue their education, financial assistance can make all the difference. Through your prayers and financial support, these young people are given the opportunity to continue their schooling and, ultimately, pursue training for specific

careers and a brighter future. Applications for the 2027 school year are now being accepted by the joint scholarship committee of the St. Paul Area Synod and the Iringa Diocese. Following student interviews, the amount of assistance the committee can provide will depend upon the funds available.
