

We are deeply grateful for all the positive feedback we've received on the reconstructed retaining wall, the new patio, and the upcoming resurfacing of the main entrance parking lot. Recently, we were blessed with several generous donations totaling over \$80,000—an incredible milestone in our fundraising journey! This will enable the parking lot to be completed, and word has it that it will happen this fall. Miller Excavating will be doing the work

At this time, we continue to accept only financial contributions for the project, including the purchase of the four remaining blocks. In the meantime, many of you have already shared wonderful ideas for how the new patio could be used, and we look forward to hearing even more in the coming months.

To help guide this process, our working group will begin developing guidelines and best practices for the patio, including recommendations for furnishings. Final decisions about its use and design will be formalized by the council next spring.
