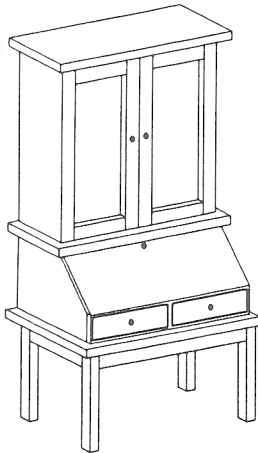


# 1/4" Scale Country Secretary

Cut all wood per drawing. Note the multiple parts in ( ) 's. Stain as desired using oil base stain. We use Minwax Golden Oak.

## Leg Unit Directions

Glue block sides to block as shown in diagram.

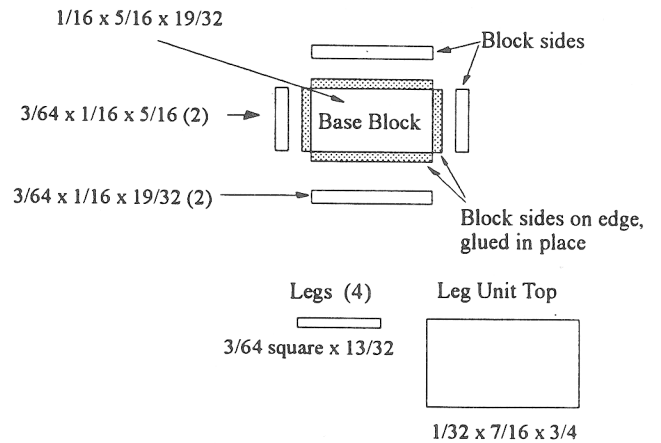
**Ensure sides are on edge so that thickness matches block!**

Glue legs into corners, making sure they are straight & square.

If your sides are on correctly, you will have 4 square corners.

Glue on leg unit top, flush at back, centered left to right.

| Wood List   | Used For                    |
|-------------|-----------------------------|
| .012 x 3/32 | Desk drawers                |
| 1/32 x 1/16 | Top doors                   |
| 1/32 x 1/8  | Desk drawer front           |
| 1/32 X 1/4  | Top sides, desk slant       |
| 1/32 x 9/32 | Top top, desk top,          |
| 1/32 x 3/8  | Desk sides                  |
| 1/32 x 7/16 | Leg base top                |
| 1/32 x 5/8  | Top back & front, desk back |
| 3/64 square | Legs                        |
| 3/64 x 1/16 | Block front & back, sides   |
| 1/16 x 5/16 | Leg block                   |



## Desk Unit Directions

Glue drawers to front.

Indent drawers with SHARP pencil where knobs will go.

Indent top center of desk with SHARP pencil where knob will go.

Glue back between sides - short edge to front.

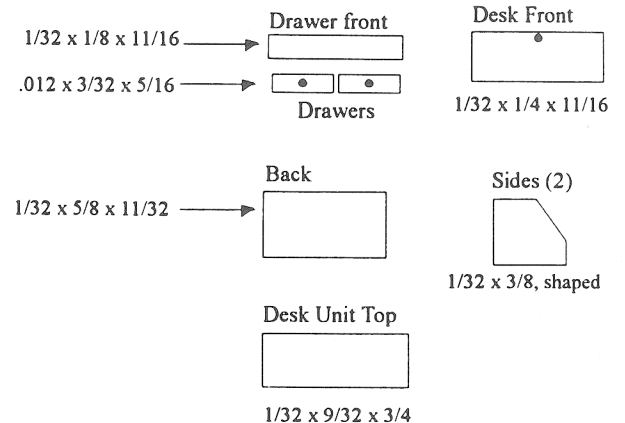
Glue drawer unit on top of sides.

Glue desk front on top of angled section of sides.

If necessary, lightly sand top and bottom edges of desk unit so it will fit flush with the other units.

Glue on desk unit top, flush at back, centered left to right.

Glue to leg unit, flush at back.



## Top Unit Directions

Glue door pieces to front. Work from outside edges to middle.

See picture for layout.

Indent with SHARP pencil for knobs. See picture.

Lay door unit face down and glue between sides.

Glue back BETWEEN sides.

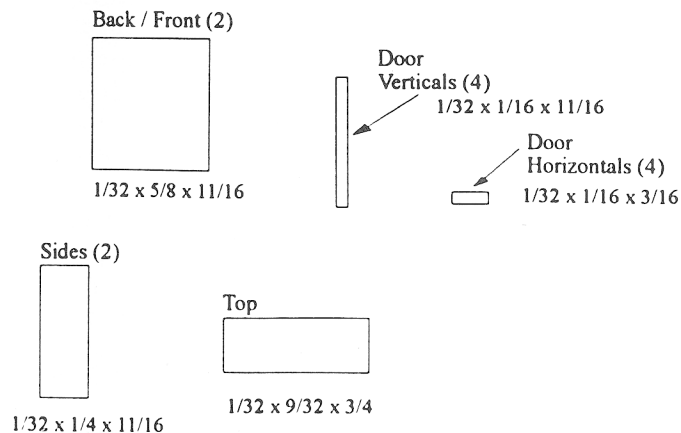
If necessary, lightly sand top and bottom even.

Glue top on, flush at back, centered left to right.

Glue to desk unit, flush at back.

Glue on knobs.

Finish with a coat of semigloss Deft, if desired.



**Knobs:** Use tiny beads.
