

## Chefs Hat and Apron Instructions

Cut the Hat body pattern from white card stock. *Note: the Grayed area is the overlap*

Cut the rest of the pattern pieces from white cotton. Cut two of the apron belt pieces.

### Hat

Cover the cardstock body piece with the white fabric piece. Leave a bit of white fabric over one end. Roll the body piece into a cylinder. The extra white fabric is glued down and will help to hide the seam.

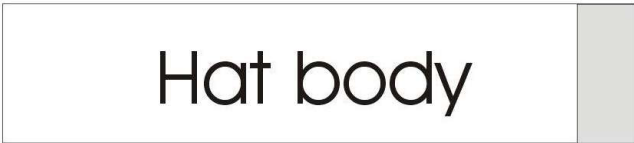
Use a needle and thread to gather the circle, with roughly a 1/4" edge. This does not have to be perfect. Pull the gather to fit just inside the top of the cylinder. Glue them together.

### Apron

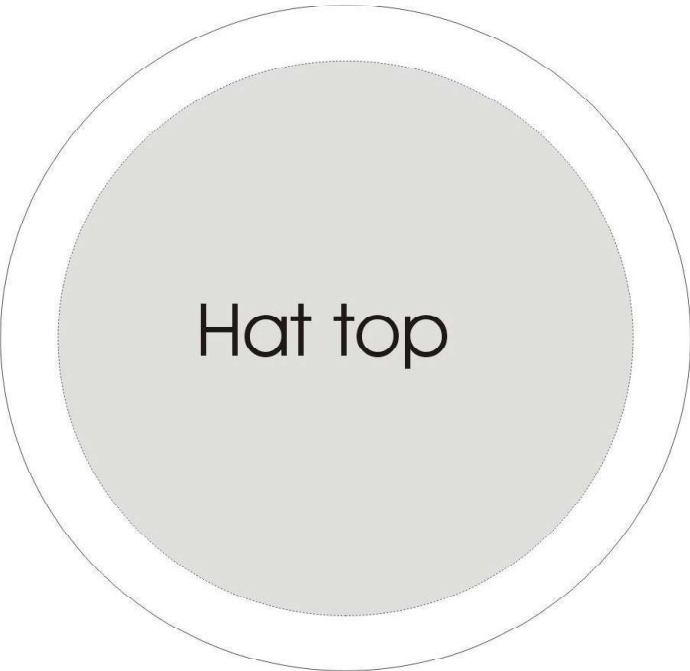
Lightly paint the edges with glue and fold over to make a finished edge all around.

Butter the entire belt piece thinly with glue. Fold over each edge so that it is a long narrow strip.

Glue one strip across the front of the apron where the top parts start to curve. Glue on end of the other strip behind the one top corner. Make a loop and glue to the other top corner. Cut off the excess and discard.

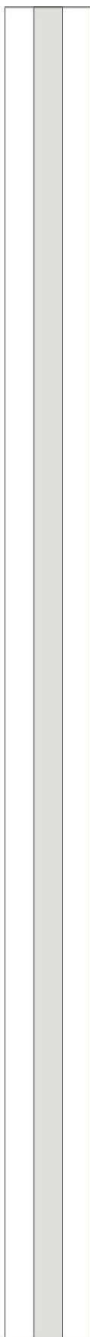
Hat body
