Here is my version of the Camp Makamini cabin. We love how she added that tree house reading nook.

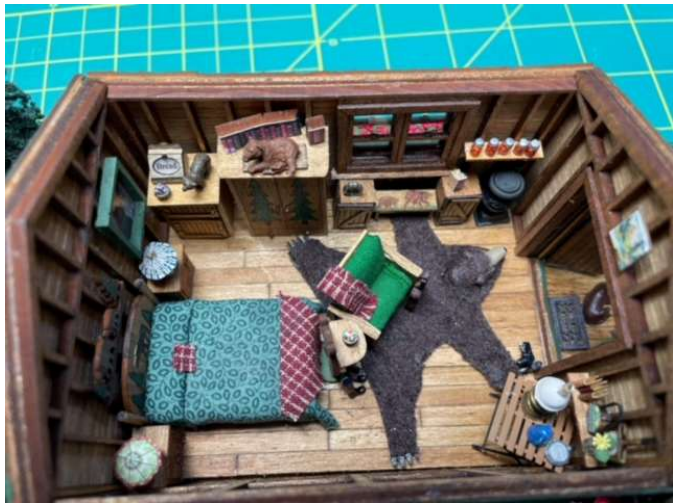

This challenge has “challenged” me to finish the previous years’ projects, so maybe I can send more pictures before the month is over. 😊

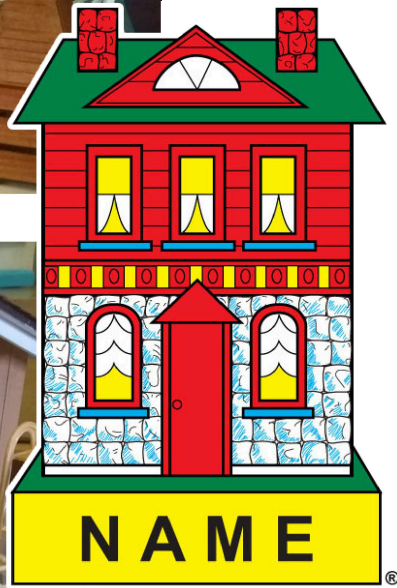




From Vicki Scidmore:
