All members of the Board were present, except Commissioner(s) Marsha Goates, thus constituting a quorum. Whereupon, among other business, the following was transacted at such meeting:

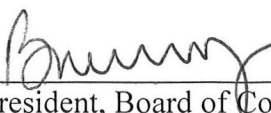
ORDER SETTING RATE AND LEVYING TAX FOR 2025

ORDER SETTING RATE AND LEVYING TAX FOR 2025

STATE OF TEXAS

WHEREAS, Fort Bend County Emergency Services District No. 6 (the "District") is a governmental agency and body politic and corporate of the State of Texas created pursuant to Chapter 775, Texas Health and Safety Code to accomplish the purposes provided by Section 48-e, Article III, Texas Constitution (the "Article"); and

WHEREAS, the Article states that the District has all the rights, powers, privileges, functions and duties necessary and convenient to accomplish the purposes of Chapter 775, Texas Health and Safety Code, as amended; and

WHEREAS, the District has amassed certain debt pursuant to Texas Health and Safety Code, Section 775.085, as amended; and

WHEREAS, Texas Health and Safety Code, Section 775.085(b), as amended, provides that the Board of Commissioners of the District (the "Board") may pledge tax revenues that are not otherwise pledged to pay the debt of the District; and

WHEREAS, Section 48-e, Article III, Texas Constitution allows for the levy of an ad valorem tax on property in the District not to exceed ten cents (\$0.10) per \$100 valuation for the support of the District, which has been approved by a vote of the qualified voters of the District; and

WHEREAS, Texas Tax Code, Section 26.06, as amended, provides that before the Board adopts an ad valorem tax rate, the Board shall give notice of each meeting of the Board at which the adoption of a tax rate will be considered; such notice of the public hearings on the District's tax rate shall be in substantially in one of the forms set forth in Texas Tax Code, Sections 26.06(b1-b3), 26.062, and 26.063, as amended, and shall be published in a newspaper having general circulation in the District at least five (5) days before the date of the hearing; and

WHEREAS, if the Board adopts a total tax rate that would exceed the greater of the District's voter approval tax rate or *de minimis* rate, the District shall be required to hold an election to determine whether to approve the adopted tax rate in accordance with the procedures provided by Texas Tax Code, §§26.07 and 26.081 and subject to the allowance for a petition for an election to determine whether to reduce the tax rate adopted by the District to the voter-approval tax rate under Texas Tax Code, §26.075; and

WHEREAS, the Fort Bend County Tax Assessor/Collector, the Tax Assessor and Collector for the District, has received the certified tax roll from the Fort Bend Central Appraisal District assessing the 2025 valuation of District property and presented such information to the Board for its consideration in setting the 2025 tax rate, including the 2025 tax rate calculations prepared by the Fort Bend County Tax Assessor/Collector which includes the debt service and maintenance and operations components thereof; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that the portion of the tax levy for debt service purposes in this Order are sufficient to provide for the District's debt service as required by Texas Health and Safety Code, Section 775.085, as amended, and the portion of the tax levy for operations and maintenance purposes of the District are permitted by the Texas Constitution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF FORT BEND COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 6, THAT:

Section 1. The Board hereby finds that, prior to adopting the ad valorem tax rate for 2025, the District has provided proper notice of the public hearing regarding the District's proposed tax rate and otherwise satisfied the requirements of Texas Tax Code, Section 26.06, as amended.

Section 2. The Board hereby levies and causes to be assessed upon all property (real, personal or mixed) subject to taxation within the District a total ad valorem tax rate of \$0.10 per \$100 of assessed value for the year 2025 which includes the operation and maintenance tax components and debt service tax components, which is an 8.64% increase in the tax rate.

Section 3. The total ad valorem tax rate is partially comprised of \$0.087012 per \$100 assessed valuation for operations and maintenance purposes.

Section 4. The total ad valorem tax rate is also partially comprised of \$0.012988 per \$100 assessed valuation for debt service purposes.

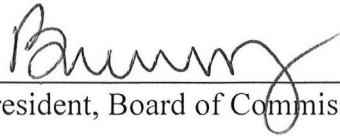
Section 5. The District's Tax Assessor and Collector shall take all steps necessary and authorized by law to collect taxes as owed pursuant to this Order. Said ad valorem taxes shall be levied, assessed and collected at the rate of \$0.10 per \$100 of assessed valuation as provided for in Chapter 775, Texas Health and Safety Code, the Texas Tax Code and all other applicable laws.

Section 6. THE DISTRICT'S TAX RATE WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR'S TAX RATE. THE DISTRICT'S TAX RATE WILL EFFECTIVELY BE INCREASED BY 26.68 PERCENT (26.68%) AND WILL RAISE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS ON A \$100,000 HOME BY APPROXIMATELY \$2.59.

Section 7. Pursuant to law, all taxes shall be due and payable on or before the 31st day of January, 2026.

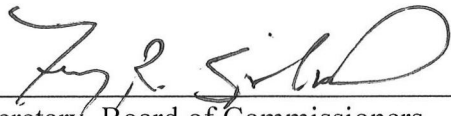
