

NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING
FORT BEND COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 6

Notice is hereby given pursuant to Texas Government Code, Chapter 551, as amended, that the Board of Commissioners (the "Board" or "Commissioners") of **Fort Bend County Emergency Services District No. 6** will hold a special meeting open to the public on **June 4, 2026, at 6:30 p.m., at Station 1, located at 6400 Hwy 36, Rosenberg, Texas 77471.**

The Board will consider and act upon the following matters:

1. Call meeting to order, join in the Pledge of Allegiance and acknowledge guests
2. Public Comment – Each member of the public who desires to address the Board regarding an item not on the agenda may speak only one time and will be limited to *3 minutes* per speaker; responses to public comment about matters not on the agenda are limited by state law to a recitation of existing policy or a statement of factual information given in response to the inquiry. Any deliberation or decision by the Board shall be limited to a proposal to place the subject on the agenda of a future meeting
3. Hear presentations and conduct interviews with representatives of strategic planning services consulting firms and take any necessary action on same:
 - a. Public Consulting Group LLC (6:30 p.m.)
 - b. Emergency Services Consulting International (7:00 p.m.)
4. Review and approve Interlocal Cooperation Agreement with Fort Bend County Tax Assessor/Collector for Collection of Taxes
5. Executive Session pursuant to Chapter 551, Texas Government Code, ("Open Meetings Act"), as necessary

The Board is authorized by the Open Meetings Act ("OMA") to convene in closed or Executive Session for certain purposes. These purposes include: receiving legal advice from its attorney(s) pursuant to §551.071, Texas Government Code; discussing real property matters pursuant to §551.072, Texas Government Code; discussing gifts and donations pursuant to §551.073, Texas Government Code; discussing personnel matters pursuant to §551.074, Texas Government Code; discussing security personnel or devices pursuant to §551.076, Texas Government Code; and discussing cybersecurity and critical infrastructure pursuant to §551.0761, Texas Government Code. If the Board decides to enter into Executive Session regarding any item on this agenda, the Presiding Officer will announce that an Executive Session will be held and will identify the item to be discussed and provision of the OMA that authorizes the closed or Executive Session.
