BASIC SERVICES OF FUNERAL DIRECTOR AND STAFF

Our professional service charge includes, but is not limited to, 24 hour availability, care and shelter of remains, conducting the arrangement conference, coordination of services, consulting with clergy, organists, coroners, recording of all vital statistic information, preparing and filing of necessary permits, certificates, authorizations and consents, answering telephone calls and e-mails with regard to the funeral, compiling obituary, maintaining our website, overhead expenses such as automotive insurance and maintenance, facility insurance and maintenance, accounting costs, employee insurance, advertising, utility expenses, secretarial and administrative costs, school and real estate taxes, equipment and inventory expenses, security alarm and camera monitoring, licensing fees, medical waste removal, continuing education expenses, and governmental compliance.
