



Overview

Every October, the streets of Surfers Paradise erupt with the roar of V8 Supercars for the Boost Mobile GC500 — one of Australia's most iconic motorsport events. With crowds in the tens of thousands, the event demands world-class organisation and seamless infrastructure delivery.

For the past six years, Advanced Temporary Fencing has been a trusted infrastructure partner, providing the essential site services that keep the event safe, secure, and on schedule. Our scope includes 15 kilometres of temporary fencing, 8 kilometres of crowd control barriers, water-filled barriers, and other critical event infrastructure. From the weeks of bump-in, through race weekend, to the final clean-up, our crews ensure the right gear is in the right place, exactly when it's needed.

The GC500 footprint presents unique challenges: compressed installation timelines, public road closures, strict safety requirements, and the need to coordinate with multiple contractors and stakeholders. To meet these demands, our experienced **Operations Team** carefully integrates delivery schedules into our works program. This ensures our trucks, installation crews, and removal teams stay ahead of the curve — avoiding delays and providing confidence to organisers.

Overview

The Cross River Rail project is one of Queensland's most significant infrastructure undertakings, designed to transform travel across South East Queensland. The project spans 10.2 kilometres, with 5.9 kilometres of twin tunnels under the Brisbane River and CBD, and includes five new stations: four underground (Boggo Road, Woolloongabba, Albert Street, Roma Street) and one above-ground at Exhibition. Scheduled for completion in 2026, the project will reduce travel times, improve connectivity, and increase network reliability for generations to come.

Since its commencement, **Advanced Temporary Fencing** has played a vital role in ensuring safety and security across multiple stages and worksites. Over the course of the project, we have delivered more than **15 kilometres of temporary fencing**, as well as **semi-permanent barriers** and **customised safety solutions** to meet the unique requirements of a large-scale, urban rail development.

Working across high-traffic CBD zones, deep tunnel sites, and evolving construction footprints has required precise coordination, strict compliance, and adaptability. Our operations team has worked hand-in-hand with Tier 1 contractors and project stakeholders to ensure solutions are delivered on time, fit for purpose, and able to adapt as site conditions change.

By providing scalable fencing and barrier systems, secure access points, and tailored solutions for complex worksites, we've helped create safe environments for workers and the public alike. Overview

The Coomera Connector - Stage 1 is a landmark infrastructure project delivering a new 16-kilometre motorway between Coomera and Nerang on the northern Gold Coast. Jointly funded by the Australian and Queensland governments, the \$3.5 billion project is designed to ease pressure on the M1, support population growth, and deliver long-term economic and transport benefits. Once complete, it will carry up to 57,000 vehicles per day, cut congestion by around 10%, and include a dedicated 16km active transport path.

Alongside its scale and complexity, the project carries a strong commitment to **environmental protection**, with several sensitive habitats located along the alignment. That's where **Advanced Temporary Fencing** and **Advanced Environmental Services** have played a critical role.

To date, our teams have delivered:

- 20km of Temporary Koala Fencing to protect local populations from construction impacts
- 30+km of Sediment Control Devices to reduce runoff and safeguard waterways
- A range of **erosion, fauna, and delineation controls** to maintain compliance with strict biodiversity requirements

With Stage 1 spanning a long, linear worksite, our crews have worked closely with Tier 1 contractors and environmental consultants to deploy solutions that are durable, compliant, and tailored to changing site conditions. Our **Temporary Koala Fencing (TKF)** system, recommended by Queensland's Department of Transport and Main Roads, has been instrumental in ensuring safe wildlife corridors across the alignment.

By integrating safety and environmental protection into one streamlined service, we've given contractors confidence that compliance and community expectations are being met. Our ability to mobilise quickly, adapt to evolving requirements, and deliver consistently high-quality outcomes has made us a trusted partner on this major project.
