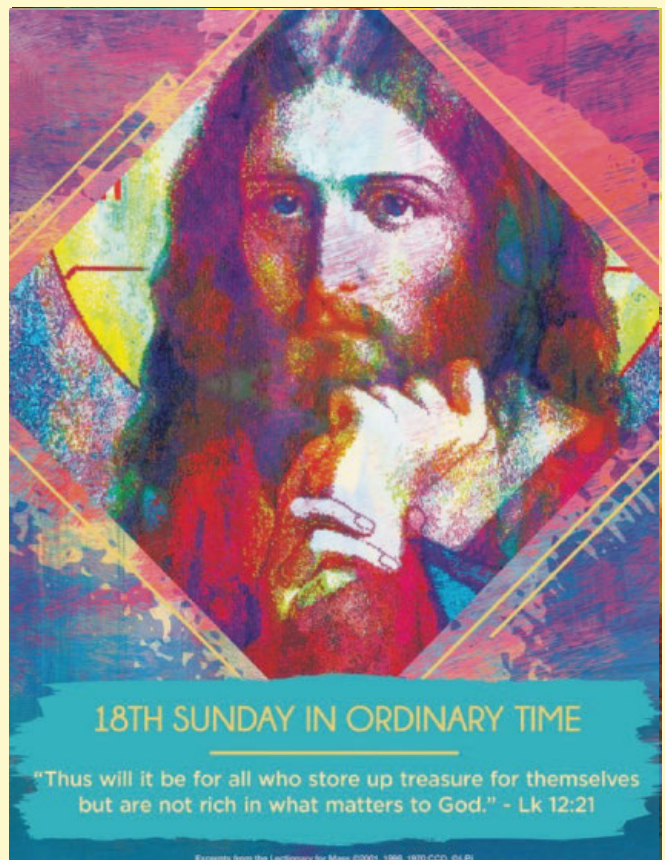

- ~ Contributions in cash can only be considered when presented in the parish envelope.
- ~ Multiple envelopes put in at a weekend Mass will be considered participation for that one Mass.
- ~ Envelopes Dropped off or Mailed will not be considered participation at Mass.
- ~ Blank Green envelopes are available in the church if needed.

Families must be Active Members for a child to be eligible to receive any Sacrament.

**Families must be Active Members to receive reduced tuition rates at
Blessed Sacrament School and Bishop England High School.**

Active status must be maintained for families in the Schools and Sacramental Program.

Priest and Confessor

St. John Marie Vianney

Basics

Name:	John Marie Vianney
Nick Name:	Curé d'Ars (The Pastor of Ars)

John Marie Baptist Vianney was born on May 8, 1786, three years before the start of the French Revolution. He was the fourth child among the six children in the family. He grew up while it was a crime to practice the Christian faith. His parents and grandparents were strong Catholics and were defiant to the dictates of the authorities, remained faithful, and formed their children in a strong Christian faith. Vianny's paternal grandparents once hosted St. Benedict Joseph Labre on his pilgrimage to Rome in 1770.

Owing to the anti-church laws, priests were banned from administering sacraments, and convents were shut down and dissolved. However, the Viannys travelled far to attend Holy Masses celebrated in farms. Little John Vianny received his first communion during a Mass celebrated in his neighbor's kitchen, behind covered windows for fear of betrayal. He received the catechetical instruction from two nuns, belonging to a dissolved convent.

The priests who risked their lives for the sake of Jesus and His people were his first heroes. His early education was disturbed owing to the French Revolution; however, he joined the "presbytery school" in his neighboring school when he was 20. He struggled in school, especially with Latin. He persisted because of his deep desire to be a priest and the patient support of Balley, his mentor. His education was again interrupted when he was drafted into Napoleon's armies in 1809. But he ended up with deserters and lived hiding in a farmhouse under a pseudo-name. In 1810, an imperial proclamation granted amnesty to all deserters, and Vianny went back to Écully to resume his studies. In 1812, he joined the minor seminary at Verrières-en-Forez and

was promoted to the major seminary at Lyons in 1813. Owing to his poor academics, he was returned to Balley, who, but, persuaded the vicar general that his piety was great enough to compensate for his ignorance. He was ordained a priest on August 12, 1815. He was appointed the assistant to Balley in Écully.

His mentor, Fr Balley, died in 1818, and Vianney was appointed pastor of the parish of Ars, a small town with 230 inhabitants. As a pastor, Vianney realized that the Revolution's aftermath had resulted in religious ignorance and indifference, due to the devastation wrought on the Catholic Church in France. At the time, Sundays in rural areas were spent working in the fields or dancing and drinking in taverns. Vianney spent time in the confessional and gave homilies against blasphemy and profane dancing. His stern sermons were later collected together in the famous "Sermons of the Curé of Ars," along with his moral Catechetical Instructions.

He came to be known far and wide for his hours at the confessionals and his counseling. People would travel to Ars, even from far-off places, as early as 1827, to consult with the 'Curé (priest) of Ars.'

"By 1855, the number of pilgrims had reached 20,000 a year. During the last ten years of his life, he spent 16 to 18 hours a day in the confessional. Even the bishop forbade him to attend the annual retreats of the diocesan clergy because of the souls awaiting him yonder".

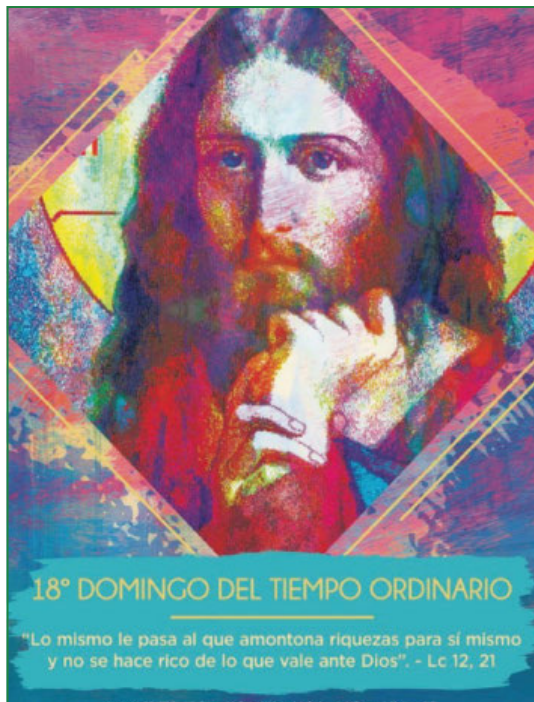
Despite all these, he yearned to lead a contemplative life as a monk and was known for his love for the poor. Vianney died at 73, on August 4, 1859.

On October 3, 1874, Pope Pius IX proclaimed him "venerable"; on January 8, 1905, Pope Pius X declared him Blessed and proposed him as a model to the parochial clergy. In 1925, John Mary Vianney was canonized by Pope Pius XI, who in 1929 made him the patron saint of parish priests.

In 1959, to commemorate the centenary of John Vianney's death, Pope John XXIII issued the encyclical letter *Sacerdotii nostri primordia*. John Paul II visited Ars in person in 1986 in connection with the bicentenary of Vianney's birth and referred to him as a "rare example of a pastor acutely aware of his responsibilities ... and a sign of courage for those who today experience the grace of being called to the priesthood."

In honor of the 150th anniversary of Vianney's death, Pope Benedict XVI declared 2009–2010 a Year for Priests.

Meditación del Evangelio - 18.º D. Ordinario

A todos nos gusta hacer planes, tener metas y llegar a ellas. Eso nos pone contentos porque nos va bien en la vida y pensamos: "Qué bien, he luchado tanto que ya puedo disfrutar de lo que tengo". Pero nos olvidamos de lo más importante: en las metas nunca contamos contigo. Nos olvidamos de que sólo Tú, Señor, nos darás la auténtica libertad y felicidad. No está la vida en poseer bienes. “Eviten con gran cuidado toda clase de codicia, porque, aunque uno tenga todo, no son sus posesiones las que le dan vida” (Lucas 12:15). BLESSED SACRAMENT LES DA LA BIENVENIDA A TODAS LAS NUEVAS FAMILIAS Y VISITANTES

¿Le gustaría inscribirse en la Parroquia Católica Blessed Sacrament? El formulario para registrarse en la parroquia se encuentra en la entrada principal de la iglesia, en la oficina parroquial y también en el sitio de internet, blsac.org.

Celebración de Sacramentos

Bautismo. Los padres que deseen bautizar a sus hijos deben comunicarse con la oficina parroquial por lo menos 3 meses antes de la fecha estimada para informarse del proceso. Una sesión preparatoria es obligatoria para los padres y padrinos. A partir de 5 años, los niños deben prepararse en el programa de Formación en la Fe y los adultos a través del programa de Iniciación Cristiana de Adultos. Interesados contactar la oficina parroquial.

Matrimonio. Aquellos con deseos de unirse en el Sacramento del Matrimonio deben llamar o venir a la oficina parroquial **al menos seis meses antes de la fecha estimada** de la ceremonia para comenzar los arreglos. Si ha estado casado anteriormente, le sugerimos iniciar más de un año antes si no ha obtenido una declaración de nulidad.

Visita a los Enfermos. Por favor, informe a la oficina parroquial si un familiar o amigo, que se encuentra hospitalizado o confinado en su casa, necesita una visita pastoral o el Sacramento de la Unción. Un sacerdote lo visitará para el sacramento y, en caso de ser necesario, dispondrá que se le lleve la Santa Comunión a su ser querido.

Sagrada Primera Comunión y Confirmación. La preparación para la recepción de estos sacramentos se lleva a cabo por el ministerio de la Formación en la Fe. La clase para adultos se ofrece a través del programa del Iniciación Cristiana de Adultos. Interesados contactar la oficina parroquial.

*Los sacramentos deben celebrarse en la parroquia donde se está inscrito. **Aquellos que desean ser padrinos o desean recibir un sacramento deben solicitar una declaración que testifica el estado de Miembro Activo. No podemos emitir tal declaración si usted no es un miembro inscrito y activo de Blessed Sacrament. (Ver “Definición de Miembro Activo” en el siguiente artículo).***

DEFINICIÓN DE MIEMBRO ACTIVO

Una familia o un individuo son considerados “miembros inscritos y activos” cuando:

1. Han estado inscritos formalmente en la parroquia por, al menos, tres meses.
2. Participan en el culto mediante la asistencia semanal a las Misas dominicales.
3. Colocan los sobres semanalmente en la cesta de la colecta en la Misa, aunque estén vacíos.

Una familia sin actividad por un tiempo prolongado se interpreta como que la familia ha dejado de pertenecer a nuestra parroquia. Si está de vacaciones por un tiempo prolongado, por favor, notifíquenos, para mantener su estado activo; igualmente si es por enfermedad, y así, además, lo incluiremos en nuestras oraciones.

- Si usted da su ofrenda en línea, por favor, en la Misa, entregue su sobre vacío. Asegúrese de haber marcado la casilla «I give online», previamente.
- Si usted contribuye ocasionalmente por medio de la colecta de la Misa, por favor, recuerde entregar su sobre semanalmente, aunque sea vacío, y marque la casilla «I attended Mass» que indica que asistió a Misa.
- Las contribuciones en efectivo solo se pueden tomar en cuenta cuando se colocan en la colecta dentro del sobre personalizado de la parroquia.
- Si coloca varios sobres en una Misa, estos se consideran como participación en esa única Misa, independientemente de las fechas que indiquen los sobres.
- Los sobres enviados a la oficina no se consideran como participación en la Misa.
- En la iglesia hay sobres disponibles para su uso, en caso de ser necesario. Estos tienen un borde verde.

Las familias deben ser miembros activos para poder optar a recibir un sacramento. Asimismo, para recibir un descuento en el costo educacional tanto del Colegio Católico Blessed Sacrament como de la secundaria Bishop England.

Las familias con estudiantes en la Formación en la Fe y los colegios mencionados deben mantener su estado de miembro activo, permanentemente.

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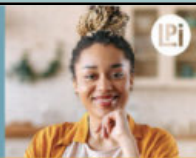
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
