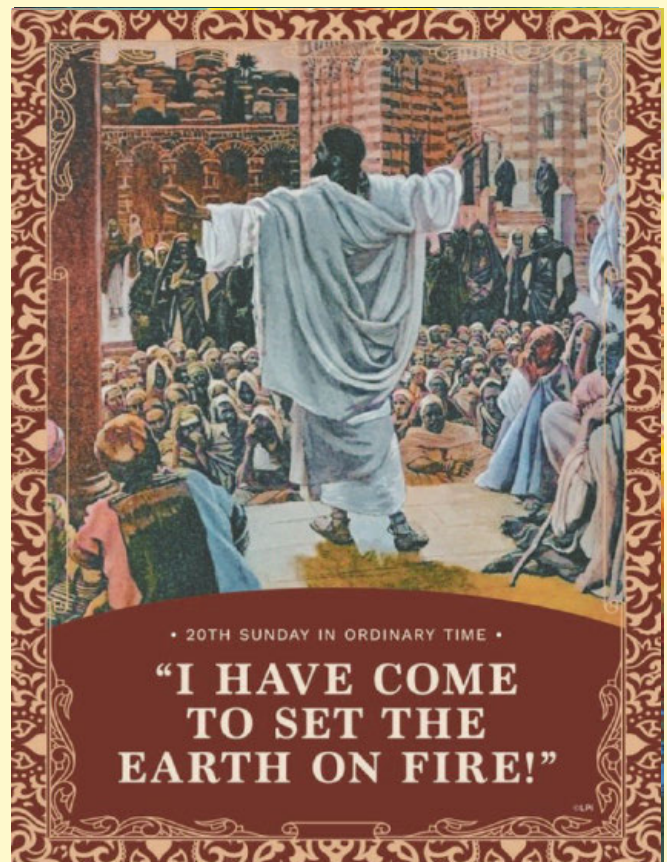

3. Places **envelopes weekly** in the offertory, even if empty.

An extended time with no activity will place a person or family on inactive status.

- ~ If you give online, please turn in your empty envelopes weekly at Mass and check "I give online."
- ~ If you contribute periodically through the collection, please remember to put in envelopes weekly, even if empty.
- ~ Contributions in cash can only be considered when presented in the parish envelope.
- ~ Multiple envelopes put in at a weekend Mass will be considered participation for that one Mass.
- ~ Envelopes Dropped off or Mailed will not be considered participation at Mass.
- ~ Blank Green envelopes are available in the church if needed.

Families must be Active Members for a child to be eligible to receive any Sacrament.

**Families must be Active Members to receive reduced tuition rates at
Blessed Sacrament School and Bishop England High School.**

Active status must be maintained for families in the Schools and Sacramental Program.

TO PARTICIPATE AS FULLY ENGAGED STEWARDS OF THE PARISH.



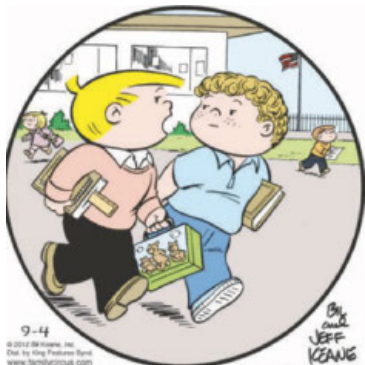

SAINT OF THE WEEK

St. Rose of Lima

Given Name:	Isabel Flores de Oliva
Chosen Name:	Rose (Rosa in Spanish)
Period:	April 20, 1586- Aug 24, 1617
Place of Birth:	Lima, Peru (Then Viceroyalty of Peru, Spanish Empire)
Parents:	Gaspar Flores & María de Olivia y Herrera
Beatification:	April 15, 1667 /1668
Canonization:	April 12, 1671
Feast Day:	August 23 (August 30 in some Latin American countries)
Patron of:	Sewing lace; gardeners; florists; people ridiculed or misunderstood for their piety; for the resolution of family quarrels; against vanity, etc.



Isabel Flores de Olivia (Rose) was one of eleven children of her parents. Her father was from the Spanish army, and her mother was a native of Lima.

She was greatly influenced by St Catherine of Siena, a Dominican Tertiary*. Influenced by her role model, she fasted three times a week and performed severe penances in secret. She was admired for her beauty, and many young men desired to marry her for her beauty and her qualities.

But she had other plans. She wanted to devote her life to Jesus and live as a Dominican nun. To make herself less attractive, she cut her hair and rubbed pepper and lime on her face and skin. Her father was not appreciative of her moves and wanted her to marry at the age of fifteen. Nonetheless, succumbing to her persistence, he allowed her to remain unmarried, although he did not permit her to join a convent. He let her have a small hut for herself on his property, and she led a life of solitude and prayer in communion with her Spiritual Spouse, the Lord.



She spent her days engaging in charitable works. She brought the poor and the sick to her hermitage and nursed them. She worked in her garden and sold flowers and bouquets to support herself and the family. She also engaged in lacework and embroidery work.

Her love for penance was at another level: she slept on a hard floor laden with broken glass pieces and other sharp objects, wore a crown of thorns, and abstained from eating meat, among other practices of penance. Upon discovering that penance opened the door to spiritual abundance, she refused to turn back. She spent her days working and caring for those in need, and her nights were dedicated to penance and prayer, restricting herself to sleep just two hours a night. Her penance, prayer, and acts of charity brought her closer to Jesus, and she was the happiest in town.

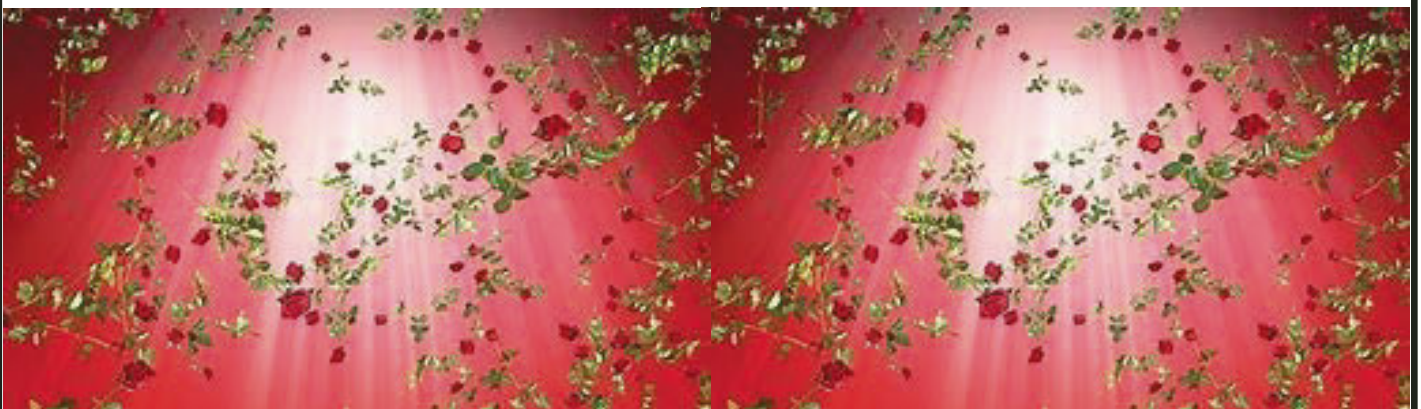
During her last eleven years, she led a more solitary life, except for the interaction necessitated by her charitable works. She availed herself of a special permission from the Archbishop, St. Toribio de Mogrovejo, to receive holy communion daily, something unusual before the early twentieth century. For eleven years she lived this way, with intervals of ecstasy, and died on August 24, 1617, after a long illness, at the age of 31.

She was the first among the saints from the Americas to be canonized.

St. Martin de Porres, a Tertiary* of the Order of Saint Dominic, and St. Rose were confirmed by St. Toribio de Mogrovejo (Archbishop of Lima). St. Francis Solano and St. Juan Macias were also contemporaries of St. Rose of Lima. A holy life is contagious!

*Tertiary order or Third Order is a lay or secular order associated with a religious order. Members of such orders live in the world, pursuing their chosen professions, but commit to a spiritual life within the order's charism and rule. They are not bound by vows like those in the first or second orders, but they strive for Christian perfection and participate in the order's charitable work. E.g. Dominican Laity, Franciscan Secular Order, Carmelites third Order, Benedictine Oblates etc.

Meditación del Evangelio - 20.º Domingo Tiempo Ordinario

El Fuego - Esta semana pasada he estado leyendo una biografía de San Francisco de Asís. Admito que no sabía mucho sobre Francisco al entrar en el libro, pero siempre tuve esta imagen de él como un hippie, un amante de la naturaleza tranquilo.

No estoy segura de dónde salió esa caricatura de Francisco, pero desde que he estado leyendo este libro he llegado a ver que no es cierto en absoluto. Era un amante de la naturaleza (...). Pero San Francisco de Asís no fue el cuarto miembro perdido de Pedro, Pablo y María. Era un hombre en llamas. Era un hombre ardiendo. Francisco caminaba descalzo y dormía en el suelo. Abandonó una vida de riqueza para abrazar la pobreza material que Cristo experimentó. Avergonzó a su familia y lo repudiaron. Cuando su padre se encontraba con Francisco en las calles de Asís, lo maldecía.

A veces tenemos la idea de que el cristianismo es algo cómodo y acogedor. Entregamos nuestras vidas a Cristo, y esperamos sentirnos instantáneamente satisfechos, felices, seguros y cálidos. Pero los santos sabían que no era así.

Los santos sabían que Cristo no había venido a envolvernos en una manta caliente. Cristo ha venido a prendernos fuego. Y aunque el fuego a menudo se ve como un signo de muerte y destrucción, también es el precursor de una nueva vida.

Si permitimos que Cristo prenda fuego a nuestras vidas, ¿qué quemaría ese fuego? ¿Qué maleza muerta y supurante en nuestras almas sería consumida por las llamas? ¿Qué promesa de santidad futura brotaría de debajo de las cenizas).

BLESSED SACRAMENT LES DA LA BIENVENIDA A TODAS LAS NUEVAS FAMILIAS Y VISITANTES

¿Le gustaría inscribirse en la Parroquia Católica Blessed Sacrament? El formulario para registrarse en la parroquia se encuentra en la entrada principal de la iglesia, en la oficina parroquial y también en el sitio de internet, blsac.org.

Celebración de Sacramentos

Bautismo. Los padres que deseen bautizar a sus hijos deben comunicarse con la oficina parroquial por lo menos 3 meses antes de la fecha estimada para informarse del proceso. Una sesión preparatoria es obligatoria para los padres y padrinos. A partir de 5 años, los niños deben prepararse en el programa de Formación en la Fe y los adultos a través del programa de Iniciación Cristiana de Adultos. Interesados contactar la oficina parroquial.

Matrimonio. Aquellos con deseos de unirse en el Sacramento del Matrimonio deben llamar o venir a la oficina parroquial al menos seis meses antes de la fecha estimada de la ceremonia para comenzar los arreglos. Si ha estado casado anteriormente, le sugerimos iniciar más de un año antes si no ha obtenido una declaración de nulidad.

Visita a los Enfermos. Por favor, informe a la oficina parroquial si un familiar o amigo, que se encuentra hospitalizado o confinado en su casa, necesita una visita pastoral o el Sacramento de la Unción. Un sacerdote lo visitará para el sacramento y, en caso de ser necesario, dispondrá que se le lleve la Santa Comunión a su ser querido.

Sagrada Primera Comunión y Confirmación. La preparación para la recepción de estos sacramentos se lleva a cabo por el ministerio de la Formación en la Fe. La clase para adultos se ofrece a través del programa del Iniciación Cristiana de Adultos. Interesados contactar la oficina parroquial.

Los sacramentos deben celebrarse en la parroquia donde se está inscrito. Aquellos que desean ser padrinos o desean recibir un sacramento deben solicitar una declaración que testifica el estado de Miembro Activo. No podemos emitir tal declaración si usted no es un miembro inscrito y activo de Blessed Sacrament. (Ver “Definición de Miembro Activo” en el siguiente artículo).

DEFINICIÓN DE MIEMBRO ACTIVO

Una familia o un individuo son considerados “miembros inscritos y activos” cuando:

1. Han estado inscritos formalmente en la parroquia por, al menos, tres meses.
2. Participan en el culto mediante la asistencia semanal a las Misas dominicales.
3. Colocan los sobres semanalmente en la cesta de la colecta en la Misa, aunque estén vacíos.

Una familia sin actividad por un tiempo prolongado se interpreta como que la familia ha dejado de pertenecer a nuestra parroquia. Si está de vacaciones por un tiempo prolongado, por favor, notifiquenos para mantener su estado activo; igualmente si es por enfermedad, y así, además, lo incluiremos en nuestras oraciones.

- Si usted da su ofrenda en línea, por favor, en la Misa, entregue su sobre vacío. Asegúrese de haber marcado la casilla «I give online», previamente.
- Si usted contribuye ocasionalmente por medio de la colecta de la Misa, por favor, recuerde entregar su sobre semanalmente, aunque sea vacío, y marque la casilla «I attended Mass» que indica que asistió a Misa.
- Las contribuciones en efectivo solo se pueden tomar en cuenta cuando se colocan en la colecta dentro del sobre personalizado de la parroquia.
- Si coloca varios sobres en una Misa, estos se consideran como participación en esa única Misa, independientemente de las fechas que indiquen los sobres.
- Los sobres enviados a la oficina no se consideran como participación en la Misa.

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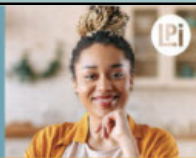
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
