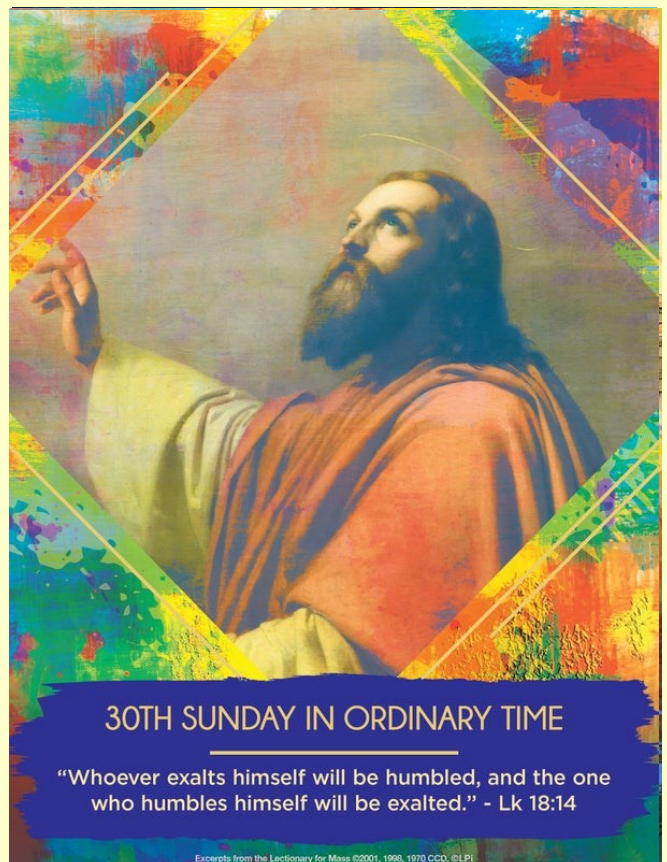

WE WELCOME ALL NEWCOMERS AND VISITORS TO BLESSED SACRAMENT CATHOLIC CHURCH. If you would like to register at Blessed Sacrament, registration forms are available at the back of the church, in the parish office, or you may register online at blsac.org.

BAPTISM: Parents who wish to have their child/children baptized should contact the Parish Office. A preparatory class is mandatory for the proper formation of parents and godparents. You must be an active member at Blessed Sacrament Church (3 months minimum) in order to schedule a baptism.

MARRIAGE: Those wishing to enter into a sacramental marriage should contact the Parish Office at least six months prior to the intended date. You must be an active member at Blessed Sacrament Church (3 months minimum) in order to schedule a wedding.

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION & CONFIRMATION: Preparations for the reception of these Sacraments are taken care of by the Office of Faith Formation. Please email blsacfaithformation@gmail.com.

VISITING THE SICK: Please inform the Parish Office should a relative/friend who is homebound/hospitalized need a pastoral visit or the Sacrament of Anointing. A priest will attend to the Sacrament.

Our Parish-established criteria is used to verify parishioner status for Weddings, Sacramental Preparation, Sponsor Certificates for Baptism and Confirmation, and to receive parishioner tuition rates at Catholic schools.

- ~ Envelopes Dropped off or Mailed will not be considered participation at Mass.
- ~ Blank Green envelopes are available in the church if needed.

Families must be Active Members for a child to be eligible to receive any Sacrament.

Families must be Active Members to receive reduced tuition rates at Blessed Sacrament School and Bishop England High School.

Active status must be maintained for families in the Schools and Sacramental Program.

TO PARTICIPATE AS FULLY ENGAGED STEWARDS OF THE PARISH.

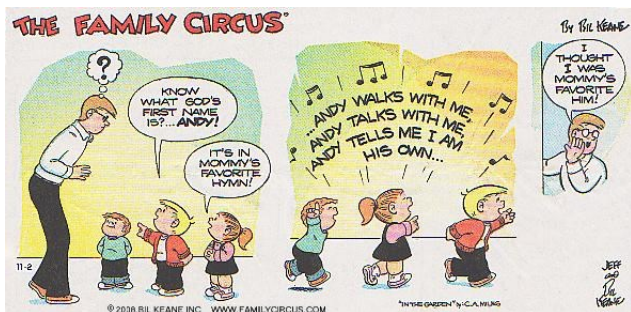

ST. PAUL OF THE CROSS

Given Name:	Paolo Francesco Dane
Nick Name:	Paul of the Cross
Period:	3 January 1694 – 18 October 1775

Saint Paul of the Cross was one of sixteen children of his parents. Only six children survived the infancy struggles. His parents moved from town to town trying to make ends meet. His father supported the family by running a dry goods store. Paul received his early education from a priest who kept a school for boys in Cremolino, Lombardy. He made great progress, and at the age of fifteen, he left school and returned to his home at Castellazzo. In his early years, Paul taught catechism in churches near his home.

Influenced by a mystical experience at the age of 19, reading of the “Treatise on the Love of God” by Francis de Sales, and his association with the members of the Capuchin Order led him to a lifelong conviction that God is most easily found in the Passion of Christ.

Wanting to serve God and the Church, he left his father in 1715 and joined the crusade to defend the Venetian Republic against the invading Turks. Soon, he realized that being a soldier was not his calling. On his way home, he stopped at Novello to help an aging but childless couple, but refused to inherit their properties. His uncle, Fr. Christopher Danei, also tried to arrange a marriage for him, but he refused. He kept the Breviary of his uncle as the only inheritance.

At the age of 26, Paul had a series of mystical experiences which clarified his vocation. He set aside his life to proclaim the Gospel with special stress on the Passion of Jesus Christ. In obedience to his vision, as approved by his spiritual directors, he went on to form an order, which he initially named “the Poor of Jesus”. Later on, it was called the “Congregation of the Passion of Jesus Christ”, or in short, “The Passionists.”

Paul was the only member of the congregation when he wrote the rule of his community at the request of his bishop, who had given him the black habit. The goal of the community was to live a penitential life in solitude and poverty, teaching people to meditate on the Passion of Jesus Christ.

Paul's younger brother, John Baptis, was his first companion. Together, they helped Cardinal Corrandini to establish and run a hospital in Rome. They dedicated themselves to providing nursing care and attending to the pastoral needs of both patients and the staff. They selected Rome as their first destination to get approval for the rule of the congregation.

The brothers were ordained on June 7, 1727, in St. Peter's Basilica by Pope Benedict XIII. They dedicated their lives to preaching missions in parishes, especially in remote country parishes that had few priests to serve them. Paul was one of the most popular preachers of his time and was known for his mercy. Their newfound community started to grow as they took their mission retreats to seminaries and religious houses.

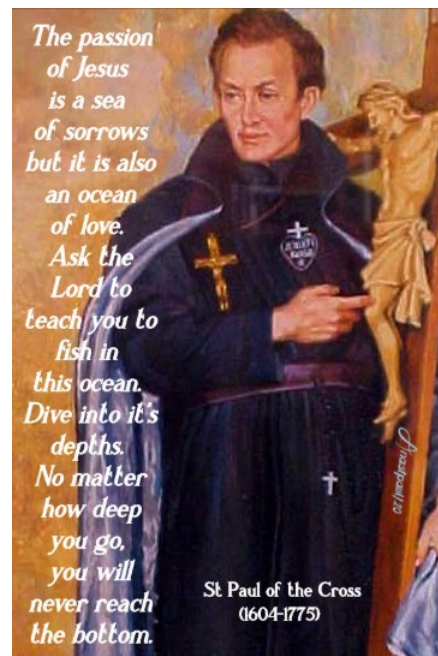
They called their monasteries Retreats, and the first Retreat was opened in 1737 at Monte Argentario with nine members. Paul called his monasteries "retreats" to underline the life of solitude and contemplation, which he believed was necessary for someone who wished to preach the message of the Cross. They had three hours of contemplative prayer in addition to the divine offices, which were celebrated in community. They lived an austere life, which discouraged many prospective members. Yet, he preferred not spectacular growth, but slow and even painful growth.

More than two thousand of Paul's letters, most of them letters of spiritual direction, have been preserved.

Paul died on October 18, 1775, at the Retreat of Saints John and Paul. At the time of his death, the community had a strength of 180 fathers and brothers living in twelve Retreats. There was also a convent for the Contemplative Nuns, which he had founded.

Nearly two thousand Passionist priests serve the Church in different parts of the world today.

Meditación del Evangelio. 30º Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario - 26 de octubre de 2025. Lucas 18, 1-8
Ante Dios no podemos fingir ni aparentar: Él nos conoce profundamente. Por más cara de buenos que pongamos, Él ve más allá: ve nuestro corazón. Tampoco podemos decirle cuán buenos somos, porque nos conoce y sabe perfectamente nuestras acciones. Hoy, Jesús nos cuenta otra parábola: la de dos hombres que fueron al templo a orar. Cada uno lo hace a su manera, y al escuchar el relato, nos damos cuenta de que uno lo hace mejor que el otro. Pero lo más importante es que los dos hablan con Dios. Con este ejemplo podemos aprender a orar y a presentarnos ante Dios tal como somos. “Efectivamente, el fariseo, a pesar de las obras, perdió la justicia; el publicano, en cambio, se granjeó la justicia por la humildad de sus palabras. Aunque, a decir verdad, la del publicano no era propiamente humildad: de hecho, la humildad se da cuando uno que es grande se humilla a sí mismo. La actitud del publicano no fue humildad, sino verdad: sus palabras eran verdaderas, pues él era un pecador”- San Juan Crisóstomo (350–407), Homilía 2 sobre la Penitencia.

“Pero, aunque somos pecadores, no debemos desalentarnos, porque el Señor está con nosotros, quien nos ha dado todo y nos hará vencer también este pequeño paso de hoy, con la gracia de la fuerza, de la valentía, de la oración, de la vigilancia y de la alegría” (Papa Francisco). En conclusión: puede ser que en cada uno de nosotros vivan un fariseo y un publicano. Ambos necesitan de Dios para ser liberados y perdonados. Ante Dios, oremos con verdad y con sinceridad de corazón.

BLESSED SACRAMENT LES DA LA BIENVENIDA A TODAS LAS NUEVAS FAMILIAS Y VISITANTES

Celebración de Sacramentos

Bautismo. Los padres que deseen bautizar a sus hijos deben comunicarse con la oficina parroquial por lo menos 3 meses antes de la fecha estimada para informarse del proceso. Una sesión preparatoria es obligatoria para los padres y padrinos. A partir de 5 años, los niños deben prepararse en el programa de Formación en la Fe y los adultos a través del programa de Orden de Iniciación Cristiana para Adultos. Interesados contactar la oficina parroquial.

Matrimonio. Aquellos con deseos de unirse en el Sacramento del Matrimonio deben llamar o venir a la oficina parroquial al menos seis meses antes de la fecha estimada de la ceremonia para comenzar los arreglos. Si ha estado casado anteriormente, le sugerimos iniciar más de un año antes si no ha obtenido una declaración de nulidad.

Visita a los Enfermos. Por favor, informe a la oficina parroquial si un familiar o amigo, que se encuentra hospitalizado o confinado en su casa, necesita una visita pastoral o el Sacramento de la Unción. Un sacerdote lo visitará para el sacramento y, en caso de ser necesario, dispondrá que se le lleve la Santa Comunión a su ser querido.

Sagrada Primera Comunión y Confirmación. La preparación para la recepción de estos sacramentos se lleva a cabo por el ministerio de la Formación en la Fe. La clase para adultos se ofrece a través del programa Orden de Iniciación Cristiana para Adultos. Interesados contactar la oficina parroquial.

Los sacramentos deben celebrarse en la parroquia donde se está inscrito. Aquellos que desean ser padrinos o desean recibir un sacramento deben solicitar una declaración que testifica el estado de Miembro Activo. Entrenamiento para monaguillos

¡La parroquia Blessed Sacrament te invita a integrarte al Ministerio de Monaguillos!

Este ministerio está formado por niños, jóvenes que han recibido su Primera Comunión. Como ministros de la liturgia, los monaguillos tienen el privilegio de ayudar a los sacerdotes, diáconos y la comunidad de la iglesia en la celebración de la Santa Misa.

A través de la preparación y formación espiritual, sirven a nuestra familia de la iglesia con reverencia, disciplina y la voluntad de liderar con el ejemplo.

Tenemos el objetivo de revitalizar este ministerio y que en Blessed Sacrament podamos contar con por lo menos 60 monaguillos.

Para esto, el Padre Bobby liderará una serie de entrenamientos para la formación tanto de los monaguillos antiguos como los nuevos que deseen iniciarse. **Son tres sábados seguidos:**

1.º, 8 y 15 de noviembre de 1 a 2:30 p. m.

DEFINICIÓN DE MIEMBRO ACTIVO

Una familia o un individuo son considerados “miembros inscritos y activos” cuando:

1. Han estado inscritos formalmente en la parroquia por, al menos, tres meses.
2. Participan en el culto mediante la asistencia semanal a las Misas dominicales.
3. Colocan los sobres semanalmente en la cesta de la colecta en la Misa, aunque estén vacíos.

Una familia sin actividad por un tiempo prolongado se interpreta como que la familia ha dejado de pertenecer a nuestra parroquia. Si está de vacaciones por un tiempo prolongado, por favor, notifiquenos, para mantener su estado activo; igualmente si es por enfermedad, y así, además, lo incluiremos en nuestras oraciones.

- Si usted da su ofrenda en línea, por favor, en la Misa, entregue su sobre vacío. Asegúrese de haber marcado la casilla «I give online», previamente.
- Si usted contribuye ocasionalmente por medio de la colecta de la Misa, por favor, recuerde entregar su sobre semanalmente, aunque sea vacío, y marque la casilla «I attended Mass» que indica que asistió a Misa.
- Las contribuciones en efectivo solo se pueden tomar en cuenta cuando se colocan en la colecta dentro del sobre personalizado de la parroquia.
- Si coloca varios sobres en una Misa, estos se consideran como participación en esa única Misa, independientemente de las fechas que indiquen los sobres.
- Los sobres enviados a la oficina no se consideran como participación en la Misa.
- En la iglesia hay sobres disponibles para su uso, en caso de ser necesario. Estos tienen un borde verde.

Las familias deben ser miembros activos para poder optar a recibir un sacramento. Asimismo, para recibir un descuento en el costo educacional tanto del Colegio Católico Blessed Sacrament como de la secundaria Bishop England.

Las familias con estudiantes en la Formación en la Fe y los colegios mencionados deben mantener su estado de miembro activo, permanentemente.
